



Adaptive Championship Event Notes

Thursday 20th June 2024

- Entry Fee: Entry is FREE for all competitors, and will include a buffet lunch provided by our sponsors
- **Sponsorship:** The first 45 entrants will receive a pair of Ear Defenders and Shooting Glasses care of our sponsor Swatcom
- **Entry Deadline:** Monday 17th June at midday
- Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by 8am Tuesday 18th June
- **Programme:** There are three events for competitors to take part in:
 - o Advancing Target: A rapid-fire match, with targets advancing from 25m
 - o Precision, Snaps & Rapid: A 3-stage 50m shoot with timed turning targets
 - o **Mini McQueen:** A sniper-style match, shot at 50m, of 10x 3 sec exposures at irregular intervals from a Mini McQueen Castle, using a scoped .22 RF Rifle

• Entry Requirements:

- ✓ The Championship is open to any injured Serving or Veteran Service personnel from British or Overseas Forces
- ✓ Competitors do not need to be members of the NRA or affiliated clubs, but are required to sign a section 21 declaration prior to shooting stating they are eligible to be in possession of a firearm and ammunition (see Terms of Entry below)
- Firearms: .22 Ruger Gallery Rifle, which create a small amount of recoil
- Shooting Position: All competitions are shot seated, with support from a rest where required
- Courses of Fire: Please see the separate Course of Fire document for full details of the Competitions
- When you Arrive: Please report directly to Melville Range by 9am where the team will issue you with shooting glasses, ear defenders (you may bring your own if you wish), and your scorecards for the day
- **Catering:** A selection of drinks and snacks will be available when you arrive, and a buffet lunch will be delivered during the day for you to enjoy. Please advise of any dietary requirements in advance
- **Scorecards:** You will complete your scorecards at the end of each shoot and then submit them to the NRA team for processing
- **Results:** Results will be displayed on a monitor on range, and will be available online after the event via: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults
- **Awards:** NRA Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals are presented for each Competition, and the overall Championship in each the Serving and Veteran Class
- **Prizegiving:** Will take place on the range, following the end of shooting

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry criteria as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - o I am an individual member of the NRA
 - o I make this declaration as a participant in an NRA Guest Day
 - o I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - o I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)

 I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Eligibility

- On the first day of the Event I will be aged fourteen years or over; OR I have the written approval of the NRA and the Event director to participate notwithstanding my age.
- I certify that I am qualified to participate in accordance with the Regulations and hold a current certificate of Safety and Competence, which I will present at the Event
- I am an individual member of the NRA; or by virtue of at least one of the following I meet the criteria to be granted,
 and I apply for, temporary membership of the NRA for the duration of the Event:
 - o I hold a UK Firearm Certificate, GB Visitor's Firearm Permit or Permit under S7 Firearms Act 1968 authorising possession of a full-bore rifle, small-bore rifle or muzzle-loading pistol
 - o I am a full member of a club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI
 - o I am a present member of HM Forces and have current military certification of competence with a full-bore rifle

Warnings:

- I agree that I have been warned that ear protection must and eye protection may be required to be worn at all
 times in the vicinity of all firing points while shooting is in progress, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for
 any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within the specific
 Event Notes for each Event
- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Event and I will accept the decisions of the
 Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of a Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, class and score
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, squadding cards will not be issued to me until these have been settled in full
