

Phoenix Meeting Team Competition Notes

Thursday 23rd – Sunday 26th May 2024

- Entry Deadline: Monday 20th May at 8am
- Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by 8am Monday 20th May.

 Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation
- **Team Nominations:** Names and GRID numbers of Team members must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 8am Thursday 23rd May
- **Discounts:** (off entry fee only)
 - o 40% Off Entry Fees for team's whose members are all under 25 years old on the last day of the Event
- Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post. All names and GRID numbers of team members need to be supplied prior to the entry deadline
- Gallery Rifle ID (GRID): This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from multiple NRA

- **Results:** Concurrent team results will be input during the Meeting, and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults
- **Awards:** NRA Medals and awards are presented to the top scoring teams in each class in each match, *unless stated otherwise*, subject to the amount of Scorecards submitted:

o 2+ Scorecards: Phoenix Gold Medal

o 6+ Scorecards: Phoenix Gold and Silver Medal

o 9+ Scorecards: Phoenix Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal

• **Prizegiving:** Will take place on Sunday 26th May at 6pm in the NRA Pavilion. All individual Gold medals will be presented, in addition to team awards. Once the results are finalised the silver and bronze medals will be sent for engraving, and made ready to collect at the Gallery Rifle Nationals in September. If they are not collected by the Gallery Rifle Nationals they will be posted out to competitors

Club Team (Concurrent):

Teams of 5 shooters, with the highest 4 scores to count. Scores are derived from the individual's Phoenix scores in Timed & Precision 1 and Multi-Target, which can be shot at any time during the Meeting

- There are four Club Team Competition categories: GRSB, GRCF, LBP & LBR Classes
- Scores from LBP / LBR iron sights and GRCF Classic events will qualify if 'standard' T&P1 and M-T events have not been entered
- All members of the Team must be from the same Rifle Club, and must enter the above competitions as individuals in the Phoenix Meeting, abiding by the event's entry criteria
- Competitors can only represent one team in each class

Sporting Statics (Concurrent):

Teams of 4 shooters. Scores are derived from the individual's Phoenix scores in Sporting Statics (5685), which can be shot at any time during the Meeting

- Team members can be from different Rifle Clubs, and must enter the above competition as individuals in the Phoenix Meeting, abiding by the event's entry criteria
- Competitors can only represent one team in each class
- \textstyle The International Sporting Rifle Trophy will be presented to the highest scoring team

Gallery Rifle International (Concurrent):

Teams of 5 shooters, with the highest 4 scores to count. Scores are derived from the individual's Phoenix scores in Timed & Precision 1 and Multi-Target, which can be shot at any time during the Meeting

- There are four International Team Competition categories: GRSB, GRCF, LBP & LBR
- All members of the Team must enter the above competitions as individuals in the Phoenix Meeting, abiding by the event's entry criteria
- Multiple teams can be entered for each: England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales, via their organising bodies
- Competitors can only represent one team in each class
- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are awarded to the top three teams in each class
- The Phoenix International Cup will be presented to the highest scoring GRSB Team
- The Phoenix International Trophy will be presented to the highest scoring GRCF Team

<u>Target Shotgun International (Concurrent):</u>

Scores are derived from the individual's Phoenix scores in Timed & Precision 1, Multi-Target and Embassy Cup, which can be shot at any time during the Meeting

- There are two International Team Competition categories: SGM & SGSA
- Teams are formed of 4 shooters per class, with the best 3 scores to count, with the addition of a non-shooting Captain if required. Up to 2 individuals can be nominated for both SGM and SGSA
- All members of the Team must enter the above competitions as individuals in the Phoenix Meeting, abiding by the event's entry criteria
- Only one team can be entered per Country into each Class
- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are awarded to the top three teams in each class
- \textstyle The Limax Cup will be presented to the Country with the highest combined score in both the SGM & SGSA events

Gallery Rifle International Team Shoulder to Shoulder: Sunday 26th May 2024

Teams of 5 shooters, with the highest 4 scores to count from any recognised shooting nation. Team scores are derived from the scores shot in the Team 1500 match on Sunday 26th May

- There are two International Team Competition categories: GRSB & GRCF
- All members of the Team must have either entered the Phoenix Meeting as individuals, or sign a copy of the NRA's entry Terms and Conditions as detailed below
- Only one team can be entered per Nation into each Class
- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are awarded to the top three teams in each class

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry criteria as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry Form is true, complete and accurate Access to firearms:
- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimise my access to firearms:
 - o I am an individual member of the NRA
 - o I make this declaration as a participant in an NRA Guest Day
 - o I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - o I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Eligibility

- On the first day of the Event I will be aged fourteen years or over; OR I have the written approval of the NRA and the Event director to participate notwithstanding my age.
- I certify that I am qualified to participate in accordance with the Regulations and hold a current certificate of Safety and Competence, which I will present at the Event
- I am an individual member of the NRA; or by virtue of at least one of the following I meet the criteria to be granted, and I apply for, temporary membership of the NRA for the duration of the Event:
 - o I hold a UK Firearm Certificate, GB Visitor's Firearm Permit or Permit under S7 Firearms Act 1968 authorising possession of a full-bore rifle, small-bore rifle or muzzle-loading pistol
 - o I am a full member of a club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI
 - o I am a present member of HM Forces and have current military certification of competence with a full-bore rifle

Warnings:

- I agree that I have been warned that ear protection must and eye protection may be required to be worn at all times in the vicinity of all firing points while shooting is in progress, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within the specific Event Notes for each Event
- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Event and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of a Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, class and score
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, squadding cards will not be issued to me until these have been settled in full
