# **Entry Notes**

Please read through these notes carefully before completing the entry form

#### 1. Entering the Meeting

#### To enter online please visit <u>online.nra.org.uk</u>.

To enter via the paper form, please return it in time to the NRA via the address listed at the end of the note section.

#### 2. TRID Number

Your Target Rifle ID (TRID) is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from previous Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your Azolve/GO Membership profile and on our website when searching from previous results: www.nra.org.uk/scores

If you do not have a TRID please leave this field blank and one will be assigned to you.

#### 3. Shooter Certification Card (SCC)

All competitors must produce their SCC at the NRA Competition Reception in order to collect their squadding cards. In the case of overseas competitors the relevant certificate must be signed by their own National Governing Body.

#### 4. Overseas Competitors

Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made at your earliest opportunity, as it can take up to 3 months to be processed. Please use the VFP application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the European Community must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable.

#### 5. Record of Rifles Used

All competitors must provide details of the rifle(s) to be used during the Meeting as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997.

#### 6. Classification of Competitors

F Class has two subdivisions under international rules FTR and F Open. Please refer to para 164 in the NRA handbook for full details

#### 7. Muzzle Energy

Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting.

#### 8. Ammunition

F Open and FTR competitors may either supply their own handloaded ammunition or purchase commercially available ammunition, including GGG which will be available only from the Range Office. All handloaded ammunition must comply with NRA Range Safety Regulations and conform to CIP standards.

#### 9. Shooting Mentors Scheme

Any competitor, particularly those entering for the first time, can benefit from mentoring by an experienced competitor. To request this service please complete the appropriate box on the entry form. You will be contacted prior to the Meeting with further details. Any suitably experienced competitors who would like to volunteer to be a mentor should contact the Shooting Division.

#### 10. Discounts

Competitors aged under 25 on the last day of the Meeting are eligible for 40% discount off their entry fees. Discounts are applicable to entry fees only.

#### 11. Prize Lists

Prize Lists are displayed periodically throughout the Meeting outside the Main NRA building. After the Meeting they will be published on the NRA website, and made into a CD and paperback book typically available in January the following year.

#### 12. Awards

Awards will be presented as per the NRA handbook. Where Match conditions, or Aggregate composition has been altered on the entry form for 2020, these amendments will overwrite the rules in the handbook.

#### 13. Cancellations

Cancellations made up to 48 hours before any given competition will be refunded. Any uncompleted aggregates will also be refunded.
