Conditions of Entry

- Competitions are open to NRA members and members of any Rifle Club affiliated to the NRA.
- 2. NRA regulations for the current year apply except where otherwise stated.
- 3. Other than Any Rifle entrants, only target rifles conforming to NRA TR Class specifications may be used. Any Rifle entrants may use rifles of any calibre up to 8mm and will have a separate prize list and prizes if more than 1 entry. Other than calibre, Any Rifle entrants must comply with NRA TR regulations.
- 4. Competitors must either: a) use ammunition issued by BCRA for the meeting, or b) use their own ammunition, which may be any commercial or hand loaded non-HME ammunition with a maximum bullet weight of 156 grains (Any Rifle class: unrestricted bullet weight, but must not be HME). Other than overall length, ammunition must be compliant with CIP specifications and NRA Rules 116, 150 and Appendix VI. (PROOF OF THIS MAY BE REQUIRED AT SHORT NOTICE). Entrants using their own ammunition may pay a discounted entry fee.
- 5. Ammunition and/or squadding cards will only be issued on production of a current NRA Shooter Certification Card, valid for TR shooting.
- 6. Schools & Colleges may supply cadet force ammunition to their students.
- 7. NRA classifications for the current year will apply.
- Sighters are convertible. Unused <u>issued</u> ammunition sighting shots must be returned, with the score card and all empty cases, to the Range Conducting Officer or his assistant at the end of the 600yds & 1000yd details accordingly.
- All ties will be decided by counting out under NRA rules with the exception of the Open and Closed County Championship, when a tie shoot will decide.
- Squadding cards and ammunition will be available from 8.00 am behind the 300-yard firing point for the Short-Range Championship and the 1000-yard firing point from 1.00 pm for the Long-Range Championship.
- 11. All shooting times quoted are approximate.
- 12. No acknowledgement or receipt will be issued unless specifically requested. Should such be required, a stamped addressed envelope must be included with any postal entry, or email address for electronic entry.
- 13. Completed entry forms together with entry fee must be received no later than Saturday 30th March 2024. (Late entries will only be accepted if target space is available and will be subject to a late entry fee.)
- 14. The Meeting Committee reserves the right to amend the rules and vary the Prize Lists according to the number of entries received. In the event of any dispute, the Meeting Committee's decision is final.
