- **Concurrent Entries:** Certain matches can be shot concurrently with DefOSC events taking place on the neighbouring Pirbright/Ash ranges for members of UK Armed Forces and Overseas Forces. Competitors must submit a claim ticket by the date advertised

## • Entry Requirements:

- The Services making up His Majesty's Forces in the United Kingdom:
  - The Royal Navy and the Royal Marines including Regular and Reserve Forces
  - The Army, including Regular and Reserve Forces
  - The Royal Air Force, including Regular, Auxiliary and Reserve Forces
- o Equivalent Services of Commonwealth and Foreign Armed Forces
- o Integrated Armed Forces may be recognised as a "Service" on application to the Shooting Committee
- Entry Fees: Thanks to generous sponsorship, all events are FREE to enter
- Entry Deadline NRA Service Rifle Championship: To shoot on Bisley Range on Fri 14 Jun: deadline is Tue 11 Jun at midday. Concurrent entries see date listed on concurrent scorecard
  - Nominal Rolls, including team nominations, must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 1600 Thu 13 Jun
- Entry Deadline Team Competitions Mon 24 and Tue 25 Jun: Fri 21 Jun at midday
- **Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to <u>competitions@nra.org.uk</u> by **8am two working days before** the day of the event you wish to cancel

## • Making an entry:

- Entries to squadded NRA events on the 14, 24 and 25 June can be made online via <u>https://online.nra.org.uk/imp155-sr</u> or via the downloadable entry form on the same webpage
- Entries to concurrent events require the nominal roll and concurrent scorecards to be completed and returned to the NRA by the date stated. These can be downloaded from <u>https://online.nra.org.uk/imp155-sr</u> once entries open
- **Courses of Fire:** Conditions and Courses of Fire (CoF) are listed in the NRA Handbook which can be found online and in a paperback book available to purchase from NRA Reception. One FREE copy will be given to each team captain at registration
- **Squadding:** Prior to the event you will receive Joining Instructions confirming specific timings and locations of each shoot
- United Service Match / International SR Team Match: Teams are required to provide 4 Butt markers for each competition. Should teams be unable to provide markers the competitions will be run in two Details with half in the Butts and half shooting. This will extend shooting times.
- **Results:** Results will be input on the day of the competition and will be available online via <u>www.nra.org.uk/liveresults</u>. Results will also be displayed on the Stats boards to the side of the NRA Main Building
- **Challenging Results:** It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that the Wing Officer records their scores correctly. Any challenges of this nature must be made immediately on the day. Following the publishing of scores online competitors have until midday on the Thursday of the following week to contact the NRA for errors relating to the digitising of the hand recorded scores. - Awards: NRA Medals, Bars and Trophies are presented to the top scoring competitors in each match, subject to the amount of entries
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Only members of British Forces as defined in Appendix XI are eligible for closed prizes
  - o Reserve Prizes: Certain matches include prizes just for members of Reserve Forces
  - **The Green Jackets:** This match is open to past and present members of all Regiments now comprising The Rifles, of The Rifles Reserves Battalions and of all attached and affiliated Regiments
- **Prizegiving:** Trophies will be presented on range for certain matches. Medals, bars and cash prizes will be posted after the Meeting to the unit address as entered on the entry form
