40th Inter Counties: Event Notes

Saturday 8th – Sunday 9th June 2024

- **Entry Fee:** R Jarvis: **£60**, Lt Col H Jones: **£660**, Long Range Match: **£675**
- **Under 25 Discount:** 40% discount off R Jarvis entry fee for those that are under 25 years old on the day of the Event
- **Meeting Membership:** £10.50
- **Entry Deadline:** Monday 3rd June at midday
- **Team Nomination Deadline:** Monday 3rd June at midday
- **Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am Wednesday 5th June**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation
- **Entry Requirement Summary** (*See Terms of Entry below for full details*):
 - ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** Each civilian shooting on a MoD or NRA range has to carry a SCC issued by the chairman of a club of which they are a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors **MUST** be in possession of their SCC when shooting on NRA ranges. If you do not have an SCC for the type of firearm you wish to participate with please contact the Competition Co-ordinator before entering
 - ✓ This competition is open to members of Home Office Approved Clubs (HOAC) who are not prohibited under section 21 of the Firearms Act (The NRA is the largest HOAC in the UK). Non-NRA members are welcome, but are required to pay the Meeting Member Fee
 - ✓ On the first day of the Competition you must be aged 14 or over (please contact the Competition Co-ordinator before entering if this is not the case)
- **Team Requirements:** Open to teams of 10 members from any geographical county in the United Kingdom, which is currently affiliated to the NRA (Para 713). Squads are qualified by birth, residence or vote, any eight of whom may shoot in the Team Matches
 - ✓ All firers/coaches/captains must come from the pre-nominated squad of ten
 - ✓ A competitor may represent any county for which they are eligible except that they may represent only one county in any one calendar year
 - ✓ Counties may, if sanctioned by the Shooting Committee, combine to form a team
 - ✓ A county in which there is only one rifle club need not also affiliate as a county
- **Making an entry:** Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post. **All individuals must book for the R Jarvis independently of the Team matches**
- **Courses of Fire:** *See the separate Match Conditions document for this event*
- **Firearms:** Please refer to paragraph 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles
- **Ammunition:** Entries include issued GGG 155g 2024 ammunition for all shooters
- **Muzzle Energy:** Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting
- **Squadding:** Once entries have closed, your entries will be allocated (squadded) and this will be communicated via email

- **Target Rifle ID (TRID):** This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from multiple Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your membership profile and on our online booking website: online.nra.org.uk/customer/info. If you do not have a TRID please leave the field blank and one will be assigned
- **Scorecard Collection:** You can collect scorecards on Friday 7th June from NRA Reception. After this point, packs will be available from the ammunition distribution tent on the morning of Saturday 8th June from 07.45
- **Scorecards:** Please ensure the TRID number of each competitor is listed on the scorecards. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams, and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be placed into the scorecard box on range immediately, before leaving the range
- **Results:** Results will be input over the competition weekend and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults
- **Challenging Results:** It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box. Competitors may challenge the digitising of scores up until Thursday 13th June at midday
- **Firearms Usage:** The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Following a Competition please go to your online profile and update your firearms usage: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages
- **Awards:** NRA Medals and Trophies are presented to the top scoring teams in each match, as well as awards for the Individual R Jarvis competition. Please refer to the Match Conditions document for full details
- **Prizegiving:** Will take place on Stickledown range at approximately 13.00 on Sunday 9th following the completion of the Champion of Champions

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry criteria as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - I am an individual member of the NRA
 - I make this declaration as a participant in an NRA Guest Day
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Eligibility

- On the first day of the Event I will be aged fourteen years or over; OR I have the written approval of the NRA and the Event director to participate notwithstanding my age.
- I certify that I am qualified to participate in accordance with the Regulations and hold a current certificate of Safety and Competence, which I will present at the Event
- I am an individual member of the NRA; or by virtue of at least one of the following I meet the criteria to be granted, and I apply for, temporary membership of the NRA for the duration of the Event:
 - I hold a UK Firearm Certificate, GB Visitor's Firearm Permit or Permit under S7 Firearms Act 1968 authorising possession of a full-bore rifle, small-bore rifle or muzzle-loading pistol
 - I am a full member of a club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI
 - I am a present member of HM Forces and have current military certification of competence with a full-bore rifle

Warnings:

- I agree that I have been warned that ear protection must and eye protection may be required to be worn at all times in the vicinity of all firing points while shooting is in progress, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within the specific Event Notes for each Event
- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Event and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of a Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, class and score
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, squadding cards will not be issued to me until these have been settled in full
