

# 151<sup>st</sup> Imperial Meeting Entry Notes

Please read through these notes carefully before completing the entry form

## 1. Entering the Imperial Meeting

To enter online please visit [online.nra.org.uk](https://online.nra.org.uk).

To enter via the paper form, please return it in time to the NRA via the address listed at the end of the note section.

Entries will not be accepted for any match after 12 noon on the day preceding the match unless special conditions apply.

## 2. TRID Number

Your Target Rifle ID (TRID) is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from previous Imperial Meetings.

Your TRID is listed on your 'GO Membership' profile and on our website when searching from previous Imperial results: [www.nra.org.uk/scores](https://www.nra.org.uk/scores)

If you do not have a TRID please leave this field blank and one will be assigned to you; alternatively contact Shooting Division for assistance.

## 3. Eligibility

**Country:** please state the Country you are eligible to shoot for even if you do not intend to shoot in international matches, as this is required to calculate your eligibility into certain aggregates and special duty exemptions.

## 4. Shooter Certification Card (SCC)

All competitors must produce their SCC at the NRA Competition Reception in order to collect their squadding cards. In the case of overseas competitors the relevant certificate must be signed by their own National Governing Body.

## 5. Overseas Competitors

Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made at your earliest opportunity, as it can take up to 3 months to be processed. Please use the VFP application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the European Community must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable.

## 6. Record of Rifles Used

All competitors must provide details of the rifle(s) to be used during the Meeting as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997.

## 7. Shooting Mentors Scheme

Any competitor, particularly those entering for the first time, can benefit from mentoring by an experienced competitor. To request this service please complete the appropriate box on the entry form. You will be contacted prior to the Meeting with further details. Any suitably experienced competitors who would like to volunteer to be a mentor should contact the Shooting Division.

## 8. Classification of Competitors

If an overseas competitor is not yet in possession of an NRA GB classification, they should state their home country's class to aid Shooting Division in determining the class to be used during the Meeting. Full details regarding overseas classifications are listed in the NRA Handbook – See appendix XVI.

Target Rifle	
X	Individuals whose names are published as Class X in the 2019 Prize List.
A	Individuals whose names are published as Class A in the 2019 Prize List.
O	Individuals who are not a Class X, A or T.
T	Individuals who in any single previous Meeting have not been in one (prior to 2019) or three (2019) or more open prize lists above the "Last O in", in any competition included on the current individual's entry form in which the firearm is given as TR (see Rule 718b).

## 9. Special Duties

All domestic competitors under 70 years of age are liable for special duties unless exemption, supported by a current Doctor's certificate is provided. Competitors required to perform Special Duties will be expected to carry them out, since they are not transferable.

## 10. Discounts

Competitors aged under 25 on the last day of the Meeting are eligible for 40% discount off their entry fees. Discounts are applicable to entry fees only (i.e. not sweeps).

## 11. OTF Swindles (Queen's and Albert)

The OTF Swindles provides valuable support to all GB and NRA teams travelling overseas including Under 25, TR, MR and F Class. Entries are allocated randomly to teams of ten concurrent with Queen's I, with similar proportions of each shooting class.

## 12. Prize Lists

Prize Lists are displayed periodically throughout the Meeting outside the Main NRA building. After the Meeting they will be published on the NRA website, and made into a CD and paperback book typically available in January the following year.

## 13. Cancellations

Cancellations made up to 48 hours before any given competition will be refunded. Any uncompleted aggregates will also be refunded.
