<u>Club Team Match (Concurrent)</u> £11.00 per team: Teams of 5 shooters, highest 4 scores in each Timed & Precision 1 and Multi-Target to count. Team members must be from the same Rifle Club, and must enter the individual competitions, which can be shot at any time during the Meeting. Team Nominations containing the names and GRIDs of Team members must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 8am Thursday 23rd May

- 4 separate prizelists for: GRSB, GRCF, LBP & LBR firearms; competitors can only represent one team in each class
- Scores from LBP / LBR iron sights and GRCF Classic events will qualify if 'standard' T&P1 and M-T events have not been entered

Sporting Statics (Concurrent) £8.50 per team: Teams of 4 shooters, highest scores in **Sporting Rifle Statics (5685)** to count. Team members can be from different Rifle Clubs, and must enter the individual competitions, which can only be shot Saturday 24th May. Team Nominations containing the names and GRIDs of Team members must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 8am Thursday 23rd May. Competitors can only represent one team in this event

• $\ensuremath{\mathbb{Y}}$ The International Sporting Rifle Trophy will be presented to the highest scoring team

<u>Gallery Rifle International (Concurrent)</u> £11.00 per team: Teams of 5 shooters, highest 4 scores in each Timed & Precision 1 and Multi-Target to count. Entries are welcome from England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales, each shooter must enter the individual competitions, which can be shot at any time during the Meeting. Team Nominations containing the names and GRIDs of Team members must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 8am Thursday 23rd May

- 4 separate prizelists for: GRSB, GRCF, LBP & LBR firearms; competitors can only represent one team in each class
- Scores from LBP / LBR iron sights and GRCF Classic events will qualify if 'standard' T&P1 and M-T events have not been entered
- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are awarded to the top three teams in each class
- 📱 The Phoenix International Cup will be presented to the highest scoring GRSB Team
- \mathbb{Y} The Phoenix International Trophy will be presented to the highest scoring GRCF Team

<u>Target Shotgun International (Concurrent)</u> £11.00 per team: Teams of 4 shooters, with the addition of a non-shooting Captain if required, highest 3 scores in each Timed & Precision 1, Multi-Target and Embassy Cup to count. One entry per International Team, each shooter must enter the individual competitions, which can be shot at any time during the Meeting. Teams are required to email their intent to enter the event by Friday 11th April to

Team Nominations containing the names and GRIDs of Team members must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 8am Thursday 23rd May

- 1 prizelists for the combination of SGM & SGSA firearms; up to 2 individuals can be nominated for both SGM and SGSA
- Gold and Silver medals are awarded to the top two teams in the combined results
- The Limax Cup will be presented to the Country with the highest combined score in both the SGM & SGSA events

Gallery Rifle International: Sunday 25th May: £110.00 per team: Teams of 5 shooters, highest 4 scores in each to count. Course of fire **1500 match**. Entries are welcome from any recognised shooting nation, only one entry in each class. All members of the Team must have either entered the Phoenix Meeting as individuals, or sign a copy of the NRA's entry Terms and Conditions (see below).

Team Nominations containing the names and GRIDs of Team members must be submitted to the Competitions Team by 8am Thursday 23rd May

- 2 separate prizelists for: GRSB & GRCF firearms; competitors can only represent one team in each class
- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are awarded to the top three teams in each class

Results: Concurrent team results will be input during the Meeting, and will be available online: <u>www.nra.org.uk/liveresults</u>. Results for the International Match on Sunday 25th will be input and displayed on range

Prizegiving: Will take place on Sunday 25th May at 6pm in the NRA Pavilion. All individual Gold medals, team silver and bronze medals, and trophies will be presented. Once the results are finalised the silver and bronze medals will be sent for engraving, and made ready to collect at the Gallery Rifle Nationals. If they are not collected by the Gallery Rifle Nationals they will be posted out to competitors

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry criteria as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry Form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimise my access to firearms:
 - o I am an individual member of the NRA
 - o I make this declaration as a participant in an NRA Guest Day
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Eligibility

- On the first day of the Event I will be aged fourteen years or over; OR I have the written approval of the NRA and the Event director to participate notwithstanding my age.
- I certify that I am qualified to participate in accordance with the Regulations and hold a current certificate of Safety and Competence, which I will present at the Event
- I am an individual member of the NRA; or by virtue of at least one of the following I meet the criteria to be granted, and I apply for, temporary membership of the NRA for the duration of the Event:
 - o I hold a UK Firearm Certificate, GB Visitor's Firearm Permit or Permit under S7 Firearms Act 1968 authorising possession of a full-bore rifle, small-bore rifle or muzzle-loading pistol
 - o I am a full member of a club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI
 - o I am a present member of HM Forces and have current military certification of competence with a full-bore rifle

Warnings:

- I agree that I have been warned that ear protection must and eye protection may be required to be worn at all times in the vicinity of all firing points while shooting is in progress, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within the specific Event Notes for each Event
- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Event and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of a Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, class and score
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, squadding cards will not be issued to me until these have been settled in full
