Entry Fees:

- 1st Entry into any McQueen event **£15.00**
- Cadet Entry to McQueen A* **£9.00** *Sponsored by Accuracy International
- Aggregate Entry **£3.40**
- Issued Ammunition **£15.60**

Under 25 Discount: 40% discount off entry fee for those that are under 25 years old on the first day of the Event

Non-Member Fee: £16.00

Entry Deadline: Monday 7th July at midday

Payment: All entries must be paid at point of entry. Overseas competitors may pay when collecting scorecards due to overseas transactions fees. Clubs and Schools can be invoiced by sending us a list of competitor names to competitions@nra.org.uk

Cancellations: Cancellation for squaddled sessions must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am two days prior to the squaddled session**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable, but due to the nature of the Meeting, you may be able to fit into un-squaddled space on the range. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation. Any entries made after the deadline can be refunded if returned to reception during the meeting

Re-Shoot Events: McQueen events can be re-shot during Meeting. Re-shoot tickets can be purchased as part of your online entry, or from NRA Reception

Entry Requirement Summary (See Terms of Entry below for full details):

- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** All shooters MUST be in possession of their SCC when shooting on NRA ranges. This is awarded to NRA Members, or by a Club Chairperson (of NRA affiliated Clubs) once a shooter has satisfied criteria as to the shooter's ability to use firearms and ammunition safely. If not in possession of an SCC, shooters may apply for a temporary SCC by emailing competitions@nra.org.uk
- ✓ **NRA Membership:** Membership to the NRA is required to shoot on NSC Ranges, and ensures the individual is covered by the NRA insurance package. Non-NRA members are welcome, but are required to pay an additional Non-Member Fee
- ✓ On the first day of the event you must be aged 14 or over (please contact the event Co-ordinator before entering if this is not the case)

Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post

Gallery Rifle ID (GRID): This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from the CSR Imperial and other events including the CSR Winter League and Action Weekends. Overseas Competitors: Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made at your earliest opportunity, as it can take a minimum of 3 months to be processed. Please use the Visitors Firearms Permit application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the European Community must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable

Courses of Fire: Conditions and courses of fire and further rules are listed in the NRA Handbook which can be found [online](#) or in a paperback book available from NRA Reception for £13.50

Firearms: Please refer to the match condition as to which firearm types can contest each match

Muzzle Energy: Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

Squadding: Competitors will be able to book squadded slots, which can be used for both their first entries, and re-shoots. The Range Team will coordinate shooting on the day, and manage reshoot capacity

When you arrive: Please report to NRA Reception where your competitor pack will be ready for you to collect. Once you are in possession of your scorecards, head to the 300 yard point of Butt 10 on Century Range where the McQueen reception gazebo is positioned

Results: Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults

Challenging Results: It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box

- Provisional results are printed on white paper and attached to the scoreboards to the side of the Main NRA Building. After results go final and are printed on yellow paper. If you wish to make a challenge to the digitising of your results you must do so whilst the results are Provisional

Firearms Usage: The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Following a Competition please go to your online profile and update your firearms usage: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages

Awards: NRA Medals are awarded to each Competition, in each firearm class, for each classification group, subject to Prize List D of the NRA handbook:

- 2+ Entries: Gold Medal
- 6+ Entries: Gold and Silver Medal
- 11+ Entries: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal

Further prizes are available (see the NRA handbook), provided by our sponsors McQueen Targets and Accuracy International

Prizegiving: Will take place on range at the McQueen 300 yard firing point on Sunday 20th July at approximately 15.30 following the McQueen finals. Prizes can be presented at the Main Prizegiving on Saturday 26th July, please inform the NRA Competitions team if you wish for you awards to be presented at this time

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry requirements as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, entry to this event will be restricted until these have been settled in full
