Entries will be accepted during the Meeting, and are all subject to availability

Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am two working days prior to booking**. Entries will be fully refunded before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable

Entry Requirements:

- ✓ Open to all CCF cadets eligible to shoot in the Ashburton, and overseas cadets
- ✓ The Cadet 1K, Cadet GRSB and Cadet McQueen are run under Guest Days. All entrants will be required to sign a Section 21 declaration prior to shooting

Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post

Cadet 1K: 1100 yards (1000m), prone, one sighting shot and five shots to count

- 15 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 14th between 3-5.30pm, and Tuesday 15th July between 3-5pm
- All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA

Cadet Clays: Sporting Trap Competition: Designed to be open to all, but is primarily aimed at Cadets that have already been introduced to the sport and have a degree of competency

- The competition is carried out over five stands where shooters engage targets that are identified by a letter which is shot in a prescribed sequence on each stand. Once each shooter has completed their stand, they then move to the right and then engage the same targets from a different direction and in a different sequence
- 20 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 14th between, Tuesday 15th July, Wednesday 16th between 6-8pm
- All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA in conjunction with the NSCS

Cadet Clay: Experience Session: Designed for cadets who just wish to give clay shooting a go

- Cadets will get the chance to engage with 10 clays
- 20 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 14th between, Tuesday 15th July, Wednesday 16th between 6-8pm
- All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA in conjunction with the NSCS

Cadet Gallery Rifle (GRSB): Standing, targets advance from 25m, cadets must fire 6 shots before targets face. This is repeated for a total of three runs

- 15 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 14th, Tuesday 15th and Wednesday 16th July between 6-8pm
- All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA

Cadet McQueen: McQueen A: Two sighting shots followed by ten appearances of three seconds, with irregular intervals varying between 10 and 20 seconds. Each appearance of the target will be in a different part of the McQueen castle, the sequence being varied for each competitor. One shot to be fired at each appearance

- 15 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th July between 5.30-8pm and Wednesday 16th between 5-7pm
- All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA

Squadding: You can book a specific timeslot when you enter for each of the above events

Team Matches: For the Cadet 1K, Clays Competition and GRSB, you will receive a FREE Team nomination card for every 4 cadets entered. These nomination cards must be completed before the cadets shoot the event

When you Arrive: Please report to NRA Reception where your School pack, including scorecards for the extra events, will be ready for you to collect

Results: Results will be input on the day of the Competition (where possible) and will be available online:

Challenging Results: It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before being signed by the Range Officer and posted in the scorecard box. Any challenges to scores before they are signed off must be made immediately to the Range Team on the day

- Results will be printed and displayed on the stats board next to the NRA Offices. If you have a query for stats they are located in the NRA Offices
- Once the Meeting has finished no edits can be made for competitor errors on the scorecards. Following the publishing of scores online competitors have until midday on Monday 21st July to contact the NRA for errors relating to the digitising of the hand recorded scores. Prizegiving: The Schools Prizegiving will take place on Thursday 17th July at 18:00 in the marquee on Exhibition Lawn. All first, second and third place awards will be presented

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, entry to this event will be restricted until these have been settled in full
