(but will be accepted, subject to a late entry fee, after that date if there is space)

Firing will be in pairs on each target

All competitors must be prepared to take their turn in the butts for marking or lighter duties.

\*For Birmingham Bisley, FTR will be in two classes:

M – anyone who has never shot in the GBFCA League and has not won an F-class medal at Birmingham Bisley in or after 2017

X – the rest

**Directions** – route from M42 junction 9

*Medals for the winning team in each class if more than one entry.*

### Competition for FTR M shooters:

**Club FTR Teams of 3 M class from clubs affiliated to the NRA - Entry free** concurrent with Competition 7 (Grand) - *The Harry Thompson Trophy* (presented by Andrew Sutton) **and three medals**

The descriptions of medals refer to their colour not their composition!

On each day:

Silver medals for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each competition, and:

- for the highest TR O/T shooter in each competition 1-6 who does not win a medal in that competition.
- for the highest FTR Class 'M' shooter in each competition 1-6 who does not win a medal in that competition.

**Registration:** All competitors must please call at the Bromsgrove RC hut by 0840 each day. They must sign on and show their Shooting Competency Certificates before proceeding to the range.

Squadding will be sent out by e-mail in advance.

**Briefing:** All competitors are please to attend a mandatory Range and Safety Briefing on 'A' Range at 0845 on each day.

## Rules and Conditions

**Ammunition** Competitors are to supply their own ammunition. All users are responsible for ensuring that it is in every respect safe, within range safety parameters and complies with Range Regulations. For TR only, maximum bullet weight is 156gr.

**HME and 6.5mm are not allowed on Kingsbury range.**

**Muzzle Brakes and moderators:** Prohibited

**Challenge Cups** All trophies must be returned at or before next year's competition. You may bring them if you are entering next year, otherwise please contact Frank Harriss (f.foh@btinternet.com).

**Conditions** NRA rules and regulations will apply.

Any disputes will be resolved by the wfra Bromsgrove RC committee on the Range.

**Targets** NRA current TR and F-class match targets will be used at all distances

**Ties** In all competitions: V-bulls will be taken into account in breaking ties. Where scores are tied in both points and Vs, 'counting out' will be used.

**Under 25** Those under 25 years pay a discounted entry fee. Please enter your Date of Birth on the entry form and pay the reduced fee.

**Prize Giving** Prize giving will take place in the Bromsgrove RC hut approximately 30 minutes after the final competition on **each day**.

**Or**, I am a full member of a Home Office Approved Club & will be shooting as a full member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold an FAC only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended.
- **I have a Shooting competency certificate for the class of firearm I shall be using and for any handloads I shall be using and I shall bring it to the meeting.**
- I permit WFRM Bromsgrove RC to store my data for the administration of Birmingham Bisley and other shooting events. The data will be kept securely and not divulged to others.
