

Ages Match Event Notes

Saturday 11th October 2025

Entry Fees: £630 per team. £378 for U25 teams

Non-Member fee: £11.00 per person

Entry Deadline: Monday 6th October at midday

Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by 8am Thursday 9th October. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

Entry Requirements:

- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** All shooters MUST be in possession of their SCC when shooting on NRA ranges. This is awarded to NRA Members, or by a Club Chairperson (of NRA affiliated Clubs) once a shooter has satisfied criteria as to the shooter's ability to use firearms and ammunition safely. If not in possession of an SCC, shooters may apply for a temporary SCC by emailing competitions@nra.org.uk
- ✓ **NRA Membership:** Membership to the NRA is required to shoot on NSC Ranges, and ensures the individual is covered by the NRA insurance package. Non-NRA members are welcome, but are required to pay an additional Non-Member Fee
- ✓ On the first day of the event you must be aged 14 or over (please contact the event Co-ordinator before entering if this is not the case)

Firearms: Please refer to paragraph 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles

Muzzle Energy: Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

Ammunition: Teams must provide their own ammunition, including commercially available or handloaded, max bullet weight of 156g

Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: <u>online.nra.org.uk</u>. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post

Team Composition: Each team consists of a Captain, Adjutant, Main Coach, 2 Sub-Coaches and 10 firers. Officers and/or coaches may shoot as part of the team of 10 firers. Teams are not required to pre-nominate shooters, and may be formed of different individuals in both matches. Names and TRID numbers of squad members need to be supplied prior to the entry deadline

Teams: Under 25s | 25-34 | 35-44 | 45-54 | 55-64 | 65s and over

Team Captains: The NRA does not nominate captains, but if you wish to be a captain or organiser for a team we will gladly advertise your details so prospective team members can get in contact with you

Saturday AM: Long Range Match:

Conditions: 2 + 15 at 900 and 1000 yards on NRA targets. Two targets per team

Timings: 0800 Team captains to report to the 900x FP on century to draw targets and receive their register

Saturday PM: Short Range Match:

Conditions: 2 + 10 at 300, 500 and 600 yards on NRA targets. Two targets per team

1455-1605 500 yards 1620-1730 600 yards (1 hour 10 minutes per distance)

Squadding: Captains are to draw for lanes prior to the start of shooting at 900x

Scorecard Collection: You can collect team packs on Friday 10th September from NRA Reception. On the day of the event packs will be with the NRA Team on range from 07:45

Scorecards: Please ensure the TRID number of each competitor is listed on the scorecards. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams, and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be placed into the scorecard box on range immediately, before leaving the range

Results: Results will be input over the competition weekend and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults

Ties: Ties in team matches will be decided in accordance with NRA rule 507

Challenging Results: It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box. Competitors may challenge the digitising of scores up until Wednesday 15th October at midday

Firearms Usage: The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Following a Competition please go to your online profile and update your firearms usage: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages

Team Championship: 1st Place 15x NRA Gold Medals, 2nd Place 15x NRA Silver Medals Individual: 1st Place in each Age Group 1x NRA Gold Medal

Prizegiving: Will take place on Stickledown range at approximately 17:30 following the completion of the event

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry requirements as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - o I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
 - o I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - o I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, entry to this event will be restricted until these have been settled in full
