



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What should I do about accommodation and catering for the event?

We are excited to announce that we will be offering **FREE** tent pitches on Sergeant's Mess Field to all competitors attending the Youth Imperial Meeting (subject to availability). Please reach out if you wish to book a pitch for the event: youth@nra.org.uk

Alongside this, we have many suitable establishments on camp that can offer accommodation and/or catering. We will be publishing a facilities guide to help competitors navigate what is available on camp.



Why is ISCRM not mentioned in publications about the Youth Imperial Meeting?

The Inter Service Cadet Rifle Meeting is not an NRA competition, unlike the CCF Schools Meeting. We are delighted that the Youth Imperial Meeting can reach a wider group of under 25 shooters and we look forward to welcoming all young shooters back to Bisley!

Is the Schools Veterans Match still running in 2026?

Yes, this match will continue. Alongside this, the Lucas trophy will continue to be awarded to the top Veterans and Ashburton team. We look forward to seeing the match continue!

What should I do if I don't have my own equipment but want to attend the Youth Imperial Meeting?

A number of events within the Meeting offer NRA loaned equipment to those who do not have their own. As we will not be running an 'Issued' category in the weekday Target Rifle competitions, we will be working with organisations on camp to provide loan equipment for the 'Open' category.

We will be releasing more information regarding loan equipment in the coming months, we recommend contacting us if you have any queries.



How is the NRA reducing costs for the Meeting?

We have opted to issue 147 grain ammunition for all Target Rifle events as this reduces event costs significantly, while still offering consistent performance at the distances shot.

Also, we will be operating with a self-marking system for the Monday - Wednesday events, allowing us to reduce marker costs. For competitors who may not have marked targets prior to the Meeting, we will be offering training to ensure the event runs smoothly.
