## Adaptive Championship 2026

Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June (0900-1400)

### Event Notes

**Programme:** The day consists of four competitions run simultaneously, with the best three scores to count towards the Championship total. Entrants will have the opportunity to take part in each match listed below as well as an additional Muzzle Loading firearm experience run on the same range complex:

- **Advancing Target:** A rapid-fire match, with targets advancing from 25m
- **Snaps & Rapid:** A 2 stage 50m shoot with timed turning targets
- **Enfield Match:** A 10 shot precision match at 25m using No7/No9 firearms
- **Mini McQueen:** A sniper-style match, shot at 50m, of 10x 3 sec exposures at irregular intervals from a Mini McQueen Castle, using a scoped .22 RF Rifle

**Entry Fee:** Entry is **FREE** for all competitors, and will include a buffet lunch provided by our sponsors

#### Entry Requirements:

- ✓ The Championship is open to any injured Serving or Veteran Service personnel from British or Overseas Forces
- ✓ Competitors do not need to be members of the NRA or affiliated clubs, but are required to sign a section 21 declaration prior to shooting stating they are eligible to be in possession of a firearm and ammunition (see Terms of Entry below)

**Firearms:** All firearms and ammunition are provided as part of the event. .22 rifles are used which generate a small amount of recoil

**Shooting Position:** All competitions are shot seated, with support from a rest where required

**Entry Deadline:** Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June at midday

**Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk)

**Making an entry:** Entries can be made online via: [online.nra.org.uk](https://online.nra.org.uk). Alternatively you may download a PDF entry form from the event page which can be returned via email or post

**When you arrive:** Please report directly to Melville Range by 9 am, where the team will issue you with shooting glasses, ear defenders (you may bring your own if you wish), and your scorecards for the day

**Dress:** Comfortable clothing that is appropriate for shooting is recommended; all ranges are under cover

- **Eye protection:** is mandatory when on or near the firing point. Loan pairs will be available on the day
- **Ear protection:** All competitors **MUST** wear ear protection when near or on the firing point of all ranges. Loan pairs or plugs will be available on the day

**Catering:** A buffet lunch will be provided on the range during the day for you to enjoy, with drinks and snacks available throughout. Please advise of any dietary requirements when booking

**Scorecards:** Your scores will be recorded on scorecards at the end of each shoot. Please ensure these are posted in the boxes on range for the NRA team to process

**Awards:** NRA Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals are presented for each Competition, and the overall Championship in each the Serving and Veteran Class
