Entry Requirement Summary (See Terms of Entry below for full details):

- ✓ **NRA Membership:** This competition is open to any full member of the NRA, or members of an affiliated County whose team is shooting in the Inter-Counties Meeting. Non-NRA members are required to pay the Non-Member Fee
- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** In Iron Sighted rifle. If not in possession of an SCC, shooters may apply for a temporary SCC by emailing competitions@nra.org.uk
- ✓ On the first day of the event, you must be aged 14 or over (please contact the event Co-ordinator before entering if this is not the case)

Entry Fees: Including issued ammunition: £66. U25s: £55

Non-Member Fee: £11.50

Entry Deadline: Thursday 28th May at midday

Team Nomination Deadline: Monday 1st June at midday

Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am Thursday 4th June**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A PFD copy of the entry form will also be available via the webpage, which can be returned via email or post

Target Rifle ID (TRID): This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from multiple Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your membership profile and on our online booking website: online.nra.org.uk/customer/info. If you do not have a TRID please leave the field blank and one will be assigned

Alternative Shooting Position: A competitor who has a physical disability (temporary or permanent) which prevents them from shooting from the prone position can apply via their entry form for permission to use an alternative position (see paragraph 134 of the NRA Handbook)

Firearms: Please refer to paragraph 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles

Ammunition: Entries include issued GGG 155g 2026 ammunition for all shooters

Muzzle Energy: Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

Squadding: Once entries have closed, your entries will be allocated (squadded) and this will be communicated via email

Scorecard Collection: You can collect scorecards on Friday, 5th June from NRA Reception. After this point, packs will be available on range from the ammunition distribution tent on the morning of Saturday, 6th June from 07.45

Scorecards: Once a scorecard has been completed it must be placed into the on the range scorecard box immediately before leaving the range

Results: Results will be input over the competition weekend and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults

Challenging Results: It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box. Competitors may challenge the digitising of scores up until Thursday, 11th June at midday

Awards: NRA Medals and Trophies are presented to the top scoring individuals:

1st Place: R Jarvis Trophy and NRA Gold Medal

2nd Place: NRA Silver Medal

3rd Place: NRA Bronze Medal

Highest scoring Under 25: U25 Silver Salver*

Highest scoring Under 23: U23 Silver Salver*

*Please note an individual can only be awarded one of the Under 25 and Under 23 prizes

Any ties for first place will be shot in the afternoon following the Lt Col H Jones team competition

Prize giving: Will take place on Stickledown range at approximately 13.00 on Sunday 7th following the completion of the Champion of Champions

Firearms Usage: The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Following a Competition please go to your online profile and update your firearms usage: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages

Terms of Entry:

 - o I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
 - o I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - o I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith.
