## 42<sup>nd</sup> Inter-Counties: Team Event Notes

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2026

**Team Requirements:** Open to teams of 10 members (Senior), 6 members (Junior) from any geographical county in the United Kingdom, which is currently affiliated to the NRA\* (Para 713). Squads are qualified by birth, residence or vote, any eight of whom may shoot in the Team Matches

- ✓ All firers/coaches/captains must come from the pre-nominated squad of ten (or six)
- ✓ A competitor may represent any county for which they are eligible, except that they may represent only one county in any one calendar year
- ✓ Counties may, if sanctioned by the Shooting Committee, combine to form a team
- ✓ **NEW for 2026:** Teams may enter a maximum of 1 Senior Team, and any number of Junior Teams. In the event that range availability is reached Senior Teams will be given priority, followed by Junior Teams from counties that are unable to field Senior Teams, followed by additional Junior Teams

\*If there is only one rifle Club then a County does not need to affiliate

\*If a County is not affiliated but wishes to enter, a reduced Meeting Affiliation fee of £25 is chargeable

**Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) by **8am Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

**Making an entry:** Entries can be made and paid for online via: [online.nra.org.uk](https://online.nra.org.uk). A PDF copy of the entry form will also be available from the webpage, which can be returned via email or post

**Target Rifle ID (TRID):** This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from multiple Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your membership profile and on our online booking website: [online.nra.org.uk/customer/info](https://online.nra.org.uk/customer/info). If you do not have a TRID please leave the field blank and one will be assigned

**Alternative Shooting Position:** A competitor who has a physical disability (temporary or permanent) which prevents them from shooting from the prone position can apply via their entry form for permission to use an alternative position (see paragraph 134 of the NRA Handbook)

**Firearms:** Please refer to paragraph 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles

**Ammunition:** Entries include issued GGG 155g 2026 ammunition for all shooters

**Muzzle Energy:** Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

**Squadding:** Once entries have closed, your entries will be allocated (squadded) and this will be communicated via email

**Scorecard Collection:** You can collect scorecards on Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> June from NRA Reception. After this point, packs will be available on range from the ammunition distribution tent on the morning of Saturday, 6<sup>th</sup> June from 07.45

**Scorecards:** Please ensure the TRID number of each competitor is listed on the scorecards. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be placed into the scorecard box on the range immediately, before leaving the range

**Results:** Results will be input over the competition weekend and will be available online: [www.nra.org.uk/liveresults](http://www.nra.org.uk/liveresults)

**Challenging Results:** It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box. Competitors may challenge the digitising of scores up until Thursday, 11<sup>th</sup> June at midday

**Awards:** NRA Medals and Trophies are presented to the top scoring teams in each match, as well as awards for the Individual R Jarvis competition. Please refer to the Match Conditions document for full details

**Prize giving:** Will take place on Stickledown range at approximately 13.00 on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> following the completion of the Champion of Champions

**Firearms Usage:** The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. - I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
  - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
  - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
  - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

#### Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith.
