**Non-Member Fee:** £17.00

**Entry Requirement Summary** (See Terms of Entry below for full details):

- ✓ **Membership:** This competition is open to NRA Members. Shooters from other Home Office Approved Clubs are welcome but are required to pay the Non-Member Fee
- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** In the firearm type you are due to compete with. If not in possession of a suitable SCC, shooters should email [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) before entering to apply for a temporary card
- ✓ **Age:** On the first day of the event, you must be aged 14 or over - please contact the event Competitions Team before entering if this is not the case

**Entry Deadline:** Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July at midday

Entries can be accepted during the Meeting, and are subject to range availability

**Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) by 8am two days prior to the squadded session. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

Any re-shoot ticket purchases can be refunded if returned to reception during the Meeting

**Re-Shoot Events:** All but the Running Deer Championships can be re-shot. Re-shoot tickets can be purchased as part of your online entry, or from NRA Reception, and are exchanged on the firing point

**Making an entry:** Entries can be made and paid for online via: [online.nra.org.uk](http://online.nra.org.uk). A PDF version of the entry form will also be available from the webpage, which can be returned via email or post

**Gallery Rifle ID (GRID):** This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from multiple NRA Competitions. Your GRID is listed on your membership profile and on our online booking website: [online.nra.org.uk/customer/info](http://online.nra.org.uk/customer/info). If not yet in possession of one, this will be issued when you make your entry

**Courses of Fire:** Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the NRA Handbook which can be found [online](http://online) or in a paperback book available from NRA Reception for £13.50

**Firearms:** Please refer to the match condition as to which firearm types can contest each match

**Muzzle Energy:** Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

**Squadding:** All entries made prior to the deadline will be allocated (squadded) to a specific time slots during the Meeting which will be communicated to you via email. Squadding is subject to change right up until the collection of your scorecards, so please follow your squadding link for details of any updates

- **“Unsquadded” events:** Any entries made during the Meetings will be unsquadded. Entries made before the deadline may also contain events listed without a time slot, this indicates there is no availability to squad them at the present time. These events are fully refundable once the unused scorecards have been returned to the NRA reception prior to the end of the Meeting. Competitors are responsible for speaking to Range Officers to fit into any gaps on range
- Please note Sporting Rifle events will be squadded among the Imperial Historic Arms Meeting, which also has events taking place at the BSR complex

**Results:** Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: [www.nra.org.uk/liveresults](http://www.nra.org.uk/liveresults)

**Challenging Results:** It is the competitor’s responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before being signed by the Range Officer and posted in the scorecard box. Any challenges to scores before they are signed off must be made immediately to the Range Team on the day

- During the Meeting provisional results will be periodically published online
- Once the Meeting has finished no edits can be made for competitor errors on the scorecards. Following the publishing of scores online competitors have until midday on the Thursday of the following week to contact the NRA for errors relating to the digitising of the hand recorded scores. Please email [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) with any challenges

**Awards:** Typically NRA Medals are presented to the top scoring competitors in each match, subject to the amount of entries, see the NRA Handbook for full details:

- 2+ Entries: Gold Medal
- 6+ Entries: Gold and Silver Medal
- 11+ Entries: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal

**Prizegiving:** Awards will be presented at the Main Prizegiving on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July at 18:00 in the marquee on Exhibition Lawn

**Firearms Usage:** The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. - I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
  - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary ‘Meeting Member’ by paying the Non-Member Fee)
  - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor’s Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
  - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

**Warnings:**

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
