**Non-Member Fee:** £17.00

**Entry Requirement Summary** (See Terms of Entry below for full details):

- ✓ **Membership:** This competition is open to NRA Members. Shooters from other Home Office Approved Clubs are welcome but are required to pay the Non-Member Fee
- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** In the firearm type you are due to compete with. If not in possession of a suitable SCC, shooters should email [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) before entering to apply for a temporary card
- ✓ **Age:** On the first day of the event, you must be aged 14 or over - please contact the event Competitions Team before entering if this is not the case

**Entry Deadline:** Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at midday

Entries can be accepted during the Meeting, and are subject to range availability

**Cancellations:** Cancellation for squaddled sessions must be received via email to [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) by **8am two days prior to the squaddled session**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation. Any entries made after the deadline can be refunded if returned to reception during the meeting

**Making an entry:** Entries can be made and paid for online via: [online.nra.org.uk](http://online.nra.org.uk). A PDF version of the entry form will also be available from the webpage, which can be returned via email or post

**Overseas Competitors:** Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made at your earliest opportunity, as it can take a minimum of 3 months to be processed. Please use the Visitors Firearms Permit application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the European Community must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable

**Gallery Rifle ID (GRID):** This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from the McQueen Imperial and other events including Action Weekends. Your GRID is listed on your membership profile and on our online booking website: [online.nra.org.uk/customer/info](http://online.nra.org.uk/customer/info)

**Courses of Fire:** Conditions and courses of fire and further rules are listed in the NRA Handbook which can be found [online](#) or in a paperback book available from NRA Reception for £13.50

**Re-Shoot Events:** McQueen events can be re-shot during Meeting. Re-shoot tickets can be purchased as part of your online entry, or from NRA Reception

**Firearms:** Please refer to the match condition as to which firearm types can contest each match

**McQueen A:** Sniper Rifle: NRA issued sniper rifles (see Para 153)

**McQueen B:** Target Rifle: Any Target Rifle (Para 150, but may be fitted with any sight) or Match Rifle (Para 156)

**McQueen C:** Historic Rifle: Any rifle and sights prior to 1945 designs: the sights and mounts must be in the spirit of the original. Any position, including Hawkins. Only the sandbags provided may be used to support the rifle

**McQueen D:** Sporting Rifle: NRA Sporting Rifles (see Para 159)

**McQueen E:** Any Sniper Rifle: Any Sniper Rifles (see Para 152). *Any rifle that matches the specification of a general issue Sniper Rifle by any government, without any alterations or additions*

**McQueen F:** Any Rifle: Any Rifle within range limits

**McQueen G:** Civilian Service Rifle: Service Optic (see Para 389)

**Muzzle Energy:** Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

**Squadding:** Competitors are requested to list the day(s) they will be at Bisley to compete, and will have their first entry squadded to a specific time on these days. The Range Team will coordinate shooting on the day, and manage reshoot capacity typically on a first come first served basis

**When you arrive:** Please report to NRA Reception where your competitor pack will be ready for you to collect. Once you are in possession of your scorecards, head to the 300 yard point of Butt 10 on Century Range where the McQueen reception gazebo is positioned

**Results:** Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: [www.nra.org.uk/liveresults](http://www.nra.org.uk/liveresults)

**Challenging Results:** It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box

- Provisional results are printed on white paper and attached to the scoreboards to the side of the Main NRA Building. After results go final and are printed on yellow paper. If you wish to make a challenge to the digitising of your results you must do so whilst the results are Provisional

**Firearms Usage:** The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. **Awards:** NRA Medals are awarded to each Competition, in each firearm class, for each classification group, subject to Prize List D of the NRA handbook:

- 2+ Entries: Gold Medal
- 6+ Entries: Gold and Silver Medal
- 11+ Entries: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal

Further prizes are available (see the NRA handbook), provided by our sponsors McQueen Targets and Accuracy International

**Prizegiving:** Will take place on range at the McQueen 300-yard firing point on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July at approximately 15.30 following the McQueen finals. You may request for trophies to be re-presented at the Main Prizegiving on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July, please contact the NRA Competitions team with any enquiries

**Terms of Entry:**

- I agree I meet the entry requirements as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

**Access to firearms:**

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
  - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
  - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
  - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

**Warnings:**

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith.
