## F Class Imperial Meeting Team Notes

This event is governed by the rules laid out in the NRA Handbook (Bisley Bible) which is available online via: [nra.org.uk/all-downloads/nra-handbooks](https://nra.org.uk/all-downloads/nra-handbooks). You can purchase a paperback copy of the Handbook as part of your entry, or from NRA Reception for £13.50. Please ensure you are familiar with the rules of the competition

### Programme & Entry Fees:

- 🎯 Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June: International Team Match **£120 per team**
- 🎯 Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July: Rutland Team Matches **£120 per team**

**Under 25 Discount:** 40% discount off entry fee when all members of the team are under 25 years old on the day of the Event

**Non-Member Fee:** £17.00 per person – applicable to all members of the team. This will not be charged if the individual has already paid for an Individual F Class Imperial Entry

**Entry Deadline:** Two working days prior to each match

**Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) by **midday two working days prior to the specific match**. Entries cancelled in time will be fully refunded (or credited), after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

### Entry Requirement Summary (See Terms of Entry below for full details):

- ✓ **Membership:** This competition is open to NRA Members. Shooters from other Home Office Approved Clubs are welcome but are required to pay the Non-Member Fee
- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** In either Telescope Rifle or Iron Sighted Rifle (depending on which class of firearm you are competing in. If not in possession of a suitable SCC, shooters should email [competitions@nra.org.uk](mailto:competitions@nra.org.uk) before entering to apply for a temporary card
- ✓ **Age:** On the first day of the event, you must be aged 14 or over - please contact the event Competitions Team before entering if this is not the case

**Making an entry:** Entries can be made and paid for online via: [online.nra.org.uk](https://online.nra.org.uk). A PDF copy of the entry form will also be available via the webpage, which can be returned via email or post

**Courses of Fire:** Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the NRA Handbook which can be found [online](#) and in a paperback book available to purchase from NRA Reception for £13.50

**Firearms:** The definition for F Class Rifles can be found under paragraph 164 of the NRA Handbook. Competitors can compete in either the F-Open or F-TR class

**Ammunition:** Competitors must supply their own ammunition, which may include handloads

**Target Rifle ID (TRID):** This is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from multiple Imperial Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your membership profile and on our online booking website: [online.nra.org.uk/customer/info](https://online.nra.org.uk/customer/info). If you do not have a TRID please leave the field blank and one will be assigned

**Scorecards:** Please ensure the TRID number of each competitor is listed on the scorecard. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams, and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be placed into the scorecard box on range immediately, before leaving the range

**Squadding:** Once entries have closed, your entries will be allocated (squadded) to a specific lane which will be displayed on the team noticeboard on the side of the Stats boards

**Muzzle Energy:** Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

**Results:** Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: [www.nra.org.uk/liveresults](https://www.nra.org.uk/liveresults)

**Challenging Results:** It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box

Provisional results are printed on white paper and attached to the scoreboards to the side of the Main NRA Building. After results go final and are printed on yellow paper. If you wish to make a challenge to the digitising of your results you must do so whilst the results are Provisional

**Awards:** Details of the specific match awards are listed in the NRA Handbook

**Prize Giving:** Presentation of all medals and trophies will take place at 6pm on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July in the NRA Pavilion (Vickers Room and Conservatory) following the completion of the Team Competitions. Entry to Prizegiving is free, but if you wish to join your fellow competitors for a light buffet this will be served from 5.30pm:

**Prizegiving meal: £13 per person:** To include a Pulled pork bap with a selection of sides: Mixed Leaf Salad, Dijon Mustard & Apple Sauce, Classic potato salad, Crunchy coleslaw, Italian pasta salad with peppers, olives, red onion and mozzarella

**Firearms Usage:** The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997.   - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
  - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

#### Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
