Concurrent Team Competitions: **£5 per team.**

Under 25 Discount: 40% discount (excluding ammo) has been applied to the entry fee for events where all members of the team are under 25 years old, or in full time education

Non-Member Fee: £17 per person. All members of the team must be either full NRA members or take out temporary Meeting Membership. This will not be charged if the individual has already paid the non-member fee as part of an individual Target Rifle Imperial Entry

County Meeting Affiliation Fee: £25

Partial Refunds for ammo not draw: Team may receive a refund against their entry fee in matches shot concurrently, representing the value of ammunition not drawn, when a score made for another team is counted concurrently. Teams must request an ammunition refund claim card from the armoury team when drawing ammunition, and return the completed form to NRA Reception. Please see para 777 of the NRA handbook for full procedure details

Entry Requirement Summary (See Terms of Entry below for full details):

- ✓ **Membership:** This competition is open to NRA Members. Shooters and non-shooting members of the team from other Home Office Approved Clubs are welcome but are required to pay the Non-Member Fee
- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** In Iron sighted rifle. If not in possession of a suitable SCC, shooters should email competitions@nra.org.uk before entering to apply for a temporary card
- ✓ **Age:** On the first day of the event, you must be aged 14 or over - please contact the event Competitions Team before entering if this is not the case
- ✓ **Para 778:** A person participating in any capacity as a team member in a squaddled team competition (other than the Schools' Veterans and the Vizianagram) who has not made an individual entry must, before the competition commences and before firing in connection with the competition, submit a Simple Registration form, obtainable on request from Competitions staff, to the NRA Reception. A team official may complete a Simple Registration on behalf of such a competitor
- ✓ **County Competitions:** From any geographical county in the United Kingdom, which is currently affiliated to the NRA (Para 713). If there is only one rifle Club then a County does not need to affiliate. If a County is not affiliated but wishes to enter, a reduced Meeting Affiliation fee of £25 is chargeable

Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am two working days prior to each competition**. Entries cancelled in time will be fully refunded (or credited), after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post

Courses of Fire: Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the NRA Handbook, which can be found [online](#) and in a paperback book available to purchase from NRA Reception

Firearms: Please refer to paragraphs 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles

Ammunition: Entries included issued GGG 155g ammunition for all shooters

Muzzle Energy: Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

Squadding: Once entries have closed, your entries will be allocated (squadded) to a specific lane which will be displayed on the team noticeboard to the side of the Main NRA building

Scorecards: Please ensure the TRID number of each competitor is listed on the scorecard. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams, and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be placed into the scorecard box on range immediately, before leaving the range

Results: Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults

Challenging Results: It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting cards into the scorecard box

Provisional results are printed on white paper and attached to the scoreboards to the side of the Main NRA Building. After results go final and are printed on yellow paper. If you wish to make a challenge to the digitising of your results you must do so whilst the results are Provisional

Awards: Details of the specific match awards are listed in the NRA Handbook

Prizegiving: The Main Prizegiving will take place on Saturday, 25th July at 18:00 in the marquee on Exhibition Lawn

Firearms Usage: The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Following a Competition please go to your online profile and update your firearms usage: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry requirements as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score

- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, entry to this event will be restricted until these have been settled in full
