Individual Competitions: Thursday 11 June – NRA Service Rifle Championship, Hythe Ranges Serial 10

09:00-12:30: Short Range Rural Contact Assessment

13:00-16:30: Advance to Contact Assessment

Entry Deadline: NRA Service Rifle Championship: Mon 8th June. Nominal Rolls, including team nominations, must be submitted to competitions@nra.org.uk by Monday 8th June.

Special Award Categories:

Closed Prizes: Only members of British Forces are eligible for closed prizes

Green Jackets: Past and present members of all Regiments now comprising The Rifles, The Rifles Reserves Battalions and of all attached and affiliated Regiments

Home Guard: Only open to Volunteers, defined as:

- (i) A serving member of the RNR or RMR, (which includes RNR list 6, 7 and 8 and RMR list 2)
- (ii) A serving member of the Army Reserve (which includes Type B and C commissions and UOTC)
- (iii) A serving member of the RAuxAF or the various branches of the RAFVR
- (iv) An adult serving member of any cadet organisation

NB: A Regular may not compete as a Volunteer even if he is posted to a Volunteer Unit

Team Competitions: Thursday 18 June - Hythe Ranges Serial 10

09:00-12:00 United Service Match (Short Range Rural Contact) Teams of 8 firers from HM Forces of each Service and visiting overseas Service Rifle teams (see NRA Bisley Bible). The match will be shot on SARTS. No coaching is permitted.

13:00-16:00 International Service Rifle Team Match: Teams of 8 firers who are present members of the Regular or Reserve Armed Forces: one team from the United Kingdom, and one team from each other country present whose national shooting organisation has been recognised by the NRA of Great Britain. The match will be shot on Serial 2 as a Gallery Range. The competition will be run in two Details with half in the Butts and half shooting, followed by a changeover.
