15th European Long Range Championship Event Notes

Saturday 31st October – Sunday 1st November 2026

This event is governed by the rules laid out in the NRA Handbook (Bisley Bible), which is available online via: nra.org.uk/all-downloads/nra-handbooks. Please ensure you are familiar with the rules of the competition

Entry Fees: £1500 per Senior team. £1000 per Junior Team (£720 for U25 teams)

Non-NRA Member fee: £11.50 per person

Entry Deadline: Thursday 22nd October at midday

Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am Thursday 29th October**.

Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation

Entry Requirements:

- ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** All shooters MUST be in possession of their SCC when shooting on NRA ranges. This is awarded to NRA Members, or by a Club Chairperson (of NRA affiliated Clubs) once a shooter has satisfied criteria as to the shooter's ability to use firearms and ammunition safely. If not in possession of an SCC, shooters may apply for a temporary SCC by emailing competitions@nra.org.uk
- ✓ **NRA Membership:** Membership to the NRA is required to shoot on NSC Ranges, and ensures the individual is covered by the NRA insurance package. Non-NRA members are welcome, but are required to pay an additional Non-Member Fee
- ✓ On the first day of the event you must be aged 14 or over (please contact the event Co-ordinator before entering if this is not the case)

Team Composition: Names and TRID numbers of squad members need to be supplied prior to the entry deadline

Senior Teams: Teams consist of a Captain, Adjutant, Main Coach, 3 Sub-Coaches and 12 firers and 3 Reserves. Three targets per team

Junior Teams: Teams consist of a Captain, Adjutant, Main Coach, 2 Sub-Coaches and 8 firers and 2 Reserves. Two targets per team. Senior teams may enter the Junior Championship (for free) by nominating 8 firers before the start of shooting. A senior team cannot also win the Junior Championship

Individual Championship: Open to all team members, shot in two details, two or three per target

Team Captains: The NRA does not nominate captains, but if you wish to be a captain or organiser for a team we will gladly advertise your details so prospective team members can get in contact with you

Register Keepers: Teams are to provide a register keeper to keep scores of another team, unless agreed otherwise by all captains

Firearms: Please refer to paragraph 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles

Muzzle Energy: Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting

Ammunition: Teams must provide their own ammunition, including commercially available or handloaded, max bullet weight of 156g - **handloaded ammunition is not permitted**

Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable PDF entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post if preferable

Scorecard Collection: You can collect team packs on Friday 30th October from NRA Reception. On the day of the event packs will be with the NRA Team on range from 07:45

Scorecards: Please ensure the TRID number of each competitor is listed on the scorecards. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams, and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be handed to the NRA Team immediately, before leaving the range

Results: Results will be announced on range, and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults

Ties: Ties in team matches will be decided in accordance with NRA rule 507. Ties in the Individual Championship will be counted out

Challenging Results: It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before submitting scorecards. Competitors may challenge the digitising of scores up until Thursday 5th November at midday

Awards:

Senior European Long Range Championship

- 1st Prize: 21x engraved NRA gold medals and 21x special embroidered gold badges
- 2nd Prize: 21x special embroidered silver badges

The Junior European Long Range Championship

- 1st Prize: 14x engraved NRA gold medals and 14x special embroidered gold badges
- 2nd Prize: 14x special embroidered silver badges

Individual European Long Range Championship

- 1st Prize: a large NRA gold medal and special embroidered gold badge
- 2nd Prize: a large NRA silver medal and special embroidered silver badge
- 3rd Prize: a large NRA bronze medal and special embroidered bronze badge
- 4th – 10th Prize: a special embroidered badge

Prizegiving: Will take place on Stickledown range at approximately 12:30 following the completion of the event

Firearms Usage: The NRA is required to keep a record of firearms used by competitors as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. Following a Competition please go to your online profile and update your firearms usage: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages

Terms of Entry:

- I agree I meet the entry requirements as stated in these Event Notes
- I confirm that the information given on the attached Entry form is true, complete and accurate

Access to firearms:

- I meet at least one of the following conditions that legitimises my access to firearms:
 - I am an individual member of the NRA (or temporary 'Meeting Member' by paying the Non-Member Fee)
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate or GB Visitor's Firearm Permit permitting me to use, for target shooting, the firearms that I shall fire in this event
 - I am a member of a Club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI and will be shooting as a member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')

Eligibility:

- On the first day of the Event I will be aged fourteen years or over; OR I have the written approval of the NRA and the Event director to participate notwithstanding my age.
- I certify that I am qualified to participate in accordance with the Regulations and hold a current certificate of Safety and Competence, which I will present at the Event
- I am an individual member of the NRA; or by virtue of at least one of the following I meet the criteria to be granted, and I apply for, temporary membership of the NRA for the duration of the Event:
 - I hold a UK Firearm Certificate, GB Visitor's Firearm Permit or Permit under S7 Firearms Act 1968 authorising possession of a full-bore rifle, small-bore rifle or muzzle-loading pistol
 - I am a full member of a club Approved by the Home Office, the Scottish Ministers or the PSNI
 - I am a present member of HM Forces and have current military certification of competence with a full-bore rifle

Warnings:

- I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and I will accept the decisions of the Event Director or the NRA as final
- I agree that results of the Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, country, class and score
- I agree that I have read the NSC Range Regulations in regards to the wearing of ear protection, and Appendix III of the NRA Handbook in regards to the wearing of eye protection, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith. Any mandatory details will be contained within these Event Notes
- I understand that if I have debts to NRA or NSC Ltd over 90 days outstanding, entry to this event will be restricted until these have been settled in full
