Covid-19 Notice: The NSC has put in place Covid-secure procedures throughout the camp, please make yourself aware of the various notices and instructions. If you are feeling unwell or have Covid-19 symptoms, please do not visit the National Shooting Centre (NSC), no matter how mild the symptoms

We look forward to welcoming you to The Phoenix Meeting, the NRA's annual festival of shooting; with Gallery Rifle and Pistol, Target Shotgun, F Class, Fullbore, Classic & Historic, and McQueen events spread across the Bisley ranges

Eye Protection: It is a Meeting rule that all competitors are required to wear hearing and eye protection (unless otherwise stated in individual event conditions). The NRA will not be liable for any injury sustained through the lack of appropriate protection. Please see the NRA policy statement on eye protection on the website

Zeroing: Winans Bay B will provide an additional Zeroing facility to the Zero Range. To utilise this you must first purchase a Zeroing ticket from NRA Reception, who will also provide you with a target face

Discounts:

- **10% discount** off your total event fees when entering 6 or more events
- **20% discount** off your total event fees when entering 12 or more events
- **25% discount** off your total event fees when entering 20 or more events
- **30% discount** is available if this is your first entry to an NRA Meeting
- **40% discount** is available for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Meeting

Re-Entries: Available for the McQueen, Mini McQueen and Speed Steels, re-shoot tickets can only be purchased from NRA Reception during the Meeting

McQueen Ammunition: If entering the issued McQueen events, ammunition will be included in the cost of your entry, and re-shoot ammunition tickets can only be purchased from NRA Reception during the Meeting

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received no later than midday on Wednesday 19th May. Entries will be accepted after this time, however these will not benefit from advance squadding and are subject to range availability

Cancellations: Cancellations made before midday Wednesday 26th May will be fully refunded. Cancellations after this time are non-refundable

Event Conditions: Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the GR&P Handbook which can be found online and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception

Your Support: It is a condition of entry that all competitors are expected to support the Meeting by assisting as requested, i.e. re-facing targets and acting as Safety Supervisors

Results: Results are posted periodically on the Stats boards outside the Main NRA Building and online so you can view interim results on your phone or other internet enabled device via www.nra.org.uk/liveresults. Provisional and subsequent confirmed results are available online after the completion of the Meeting

Alan Whittle Novice Trophy: This will be awarded to competitors who have not previously entered an open Meeting at Bisley or elsewhere. The winner will be whoever achieves the highest number of points in the standard medal scores system. See the GR&P Handbook for details of the scores you need to achieve in the individual events and how the points are awarded

Certification: From 1st January 2009, each civilian shooting on a MoD range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) signed by the chairman of a club of which he is a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST produce their SCC before being allowed to shoot. Full details on this subject can be found on the NRA website
