Target Rifle Imperial Meeting – Entry Notes

Friday 16th- Saturday 24th July 2021

Please read through these notes carefully before completing the entry form

1. Entering the Imperial Meeting

To enter online please visit online.nra.org.uk/tr-imp21
Paper entry forms are available to download from the same web address. Entries will not be accepted for any match after 12 noon on the day preceding the match unless special conditions apply

2. TRID Number

Your Target Rifle ID (TRID) is a unique index number that allows us to match up your scores from previous Imperial Meetings. Your TRID is listed on your Azolve/GO Membership profile and on our website when searching from previous Imperial results: www.nra.org.uk/scores
If you do not have a TRID please leave this field blank and one will be assigned to you

3. Eligibility

Clubs: You may list up to two Clubs, Primary (listed on all prize lists) and Secondary (for use by captains in team selection)

Counties: You may list up to three Counties you are eligible to shoot for, please state them in order of preference

Country: please state the Country you are eligible to shoot for even if you do not intend to shoot in international matches, as this is required to calculate your eligibility into certain aggregates and special duty exemptions

4. Shooter Certification Card (SCC)

All competitors must produce their SCC at the NRA Competition Reception in order to collect their squadding cards. In the case of overseas competitors the relevant certificate must be signed by their own National Governing Body

5. Overseas Competitors

Applications for Visitors Firearms Permits should be made at your earliest opportunity, as it can take up to 3 months to be processed. Please use the VFP application form available as a download on the NRA website. Competitors from within the European Community must include a valid European Firearms Pass where applicable

6. Record of Rifles Used

All competitors must update their Firearms Usage record following the completion of the Meeting as required by the Firearms (Amendment) Acts 1997. This can be done via: online.nra.org.uk/customer/firearmusages

7. Shooting Mentors Scheme

Any competitor, particularly those entering for the first time, can benefit from mentoring by an experienced competitor. To request this service please complete the appropriate box on the entry form. You will be contacted prior to the Meeting with further details. Any suitably experienced competitors who would like to volunteer to be a mentor should contact the Shooting Division

8. Classification of Competitors

If an overseas competitor is not yet in possession of an NRA GB classification, they should state their home country's class to aid in determining the class to be used during the Meeting

X	Individuals whose names are published as Class X in the 2021 TR Class List
A	Individuals whose names are published as Class A in the 2021 TR Class List
O	Individuals who are not a Class X, A or T
T	Individuals who in any single previous Meeting has not been in one (prior to 2019) or three (2020 onwards) or more open prize lists above the "Last O in", in any competition (<i>see Rule 718b</i>)

9. Special Duties

All domestic competitors under 70 years of age are liable for special duties unless exemption, supported by a current Doctor's certificate is provided. Competitors required to perform Special Duties will be expected to carry them out, since they are not transferable

10. Discounts

Competitors aged under 25 on the last day of the Meeting are eligible for 40% discount off their entry fees. Discounts are applicable to entry fees only

11. Membership of the NRA

Full NRA or Meeting Membership is compulsory to enter any competition on this form. Meeting Membership Rates:

£58	Adult Non-Member Fee
£23*	U21 or U25 and undergoing full-time education
FREE	U21 or U25 and undergoing full-time education, and entering the Meeting for the first time

*U21s can pay an additional £2 to upgrade to become NRA U21 members. This means no additional membership fees will be charged until you turn 22

12. Prize Lists

Prize Lists are displayed periodically throughout the Meeting outside the Main NRA building. After the Meeting they will be published on the NRA website, and made into a CD and paperback book typically available in January the following year

13. Cancellations

Cancellations made up to 48 hours before any given competition will be refunded. Any uncompleted aggregates will also be refunded

14. COVID-secure procedures
