Ear & Eye Protection: It is a Meeting rule that all competitors are required to wear hearing and eye protection (unless otherwise stated in individual event conditions). The NRA will not be liable for any injury sustained through the lack of appropriate protection. Please see the NRA policy statement on eye protection on the website

Discounts:

- **10% discount** off your total event fees when entering 6 or more events
- **20% discount** off your total event fees when entering 12 or more events
- **30% discount** is available if this is your first entry to an NRA Meeting
- **40% discount** is available for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Meeting

Different Firearms: Competitors are not permitted to enter a match more than once, unless it is with a different firearm. If you have more than one firearm that is eligible for the same event, you may make multiple entries for that event – if so please state this clearly on your entry

Re-Entries: Available for the McQueen, Running Deer and Running Boar events, re-shoot tickets can only be purchased from NRA Reception during the Meeting

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received no later than midday on Wednesday 7th July. Entries will be accepted after this time, however these will not benefit from advance squadding and are subject to range availability

Cancellations: Cancellations made before midday Wednesday 7th July will be fully refunded. Cancellations after this time are non-refundable

Event Conditions: Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the Classic and Historic Handbook which can be found online and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception

Your Support: It is a condition of entry that all competitors are expected to support the Meeting by assisting as requested, i.e. re-facing targets and acting as Safety Supervisors

Results: Results are posted periodically on the Stats boards outside the Main NRA Building and online so you can view interim results on your phone or other internet enabled device via www.nra.org.uk/liveresults. Provisional and subsequent confirmed results are available online after the completion of the Meeting

Certification: From 1st January 2009, each civilian shooting on a MoD range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) signed by the chairman of a club of which he is a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST produce their SCC before being allowed to shoot. Full details on this subject can be found on the NRA website
