Meeting Notes:

- Safe Shooter Certification (SCC): Each civilian shooting on a MoD or NRA range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) issued by a chairman of a club of which they are a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST produce their SCC before being allowed to shoot
- **Eye Protection:** It is a Meeting rule that all competitors are required to wear hearing and eye protection (unless otherwise stated in individual event conditions). The NRA will not be liable for any injury sustained through the lack of appropriate protection
- **Discounts:** (off entry fee only)
 - **10% discount** when entering 6+ events
 - o 20% discount when entering 12+ events
 - o 25% discount when entering 20+ events
 - o **30% discount** is available if this is your first entry to an NRA Meeting
 - o 40% discount is available for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Meeting
- **Cancellations:** Entries will be fully refunded if more than 48 hours' notice is given
- **Event Conditions:** Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the GR&P Handbook which can be found online and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception
- **Re-Shoots:** Competitors can only enter each competition, in each class once. The exception to this is when the event offers re-shoots (namely: Mini McQueen, McQueen and Speed Steels). Re-Shoot tickets can be purchased in advance, or from the NRA Reception during the Competition
- **Results:** Results are posted periodically on the Stats boards outside the Main NRA Building and online at <u>www.nra.org.uk/liveresults</u> so you can view interim results on your phone or other internet enabled device
- **Awards:** There is no Prizegiving following the competition, all awards will be engraved and distributed after the event. NRA Medals are awarded in each event in each class subject to Prize List D of the NRA handbook:
 - o 2+ Entries: Gold Medal
 - o 6+ Entries: Gold and Silver Medal
 - o 11+ Entries: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal
