Meeting Notes:

- **Safe Shooter Certification (SCC):** Each civilian shooting on a MoD or NRA range is to carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) issued by a chairman of a club of which they are a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST produce their SCC before being allowed to shoot
- **Eye Protection:** It is a Meeting rule that all competitors are required to wear hearing and eye protection (unless otherwise stated in individual event conditions). The NRA will not be liable for any injury sustained through the lack of appropriate protection
- **Discounts:** (*off entry fee only*)
 - **10% discount** when entering 6+ events
 - **20% discount** when entering 12+ events
 - **25% discount** when entering 20+ events
 - **30% discount** is available if this is your first entry to an NRA Meeting
 - **40% discount** is available for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Meeting
- **Cancellations:** Entries will be fully refunded if more than 48 hours' notice is given
- **Condition of Entry:** All competitors are expected to support the Meeting by assisting as requested e.g. re-facing targets and acting as Safety Supervisors
- **Event Conditions:** Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the GR&P Handbook which can be found online and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception
- **Multiple Entry:** Competitors can only enter each competition once. The exception to this is when you have different firearms that fall under the same event number, which does permit you to shoot the same event number twice. Please indicate the number of times you are entering on your entry form
- **Results:** Results are posted periodically on the Stats boards outside the Main NRA Building and online at www.nra.org.uk/liveresults so you can view interim results on your phone or other internet enabled device
