

Competition 1: Course of Fire, Rules & Entering

This competition is run in accordance to the NRA E-League Event Notes document which is available online via: online.nra.org.uk/e-league-csr-spring-2022

- Distance:** 100 Yards
- Position:** Standing/ Kneeling/ Squatting
- Targets:** 1x Fig 12c
- No of Shots:** 10 to count
- Scoring:** Outer 200mm ring: 5, anywhere else on target: 4
- Ready Position:** Standing alert position, rifle loaded with 10 rounds and made ready
- Procedure:** Targets will make 5 exposures of 6 seconds, with a 5-10 second gap between exposures

On each exposure of the target, firers are to adopt the standing, kneeling or squatting position and fire 2 shots, returning to the standing alert position in between exposures
