Briefing: All competitors are please to attend a mandatory Range and Safety Briefing on 'A' Range at 0845 on each day.

Rules and Conditions

Ammunition Competitors are to supply their own ammunition. All users are responsible for ensuring that it is in every respect safe, within range safety parameters and complies with Range Regulations. For TR, maximum bullet weight is 156gr.

There will be no facilities for HME.

Muzzle Brakes and moderators: Prohibited

Challenge Cups All trophies must be returned at or before next year's competition. You may bring them if you are entering next year, otherwise please contact Frank Harriss (f.foh@btinternet.com).

Conditions NRA rules and regulations will apply.

Any disputes will be resolved by the HWRA committee on the Range.

Targets NRA current TR and F-class match targets will be used at all distances

Ties In all competitions: V-bulls will be taken into account in breaking ties. Where scores are tied in both points and Vs, 'counting out' will be used.

Under 25 Those under 25 years pay a discounted entry fee. Please enter your Date of Birth on the entry form and pay the reduced fee.
