Schools Imperial Event Notes

Monday 11th – Thursday 14th July 2022

This event is governed by the rules laid out in the NRA Handbook (Bisley Bible), which is available online via: nra.org.uk/all-downloads/nra-handbooks, and can be purchased in paperback form from NRA Reception for £9.50

Please ensure you are familiar with the rules of the competition

The below event notes refer to the four extra competitions available to Cadets during the Schools Meeting

- **Entry Deadline:** Friday 8th July at midday
 - Entries will be accepted during the Meeting, and are all subject to availability
- **Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am Saturday 9th July**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation
- **Entry Requirements:**
 - ✓ Open to all cadets eligible to shoot in the Ashburton, and overseas cadets
- **Making an entry:** Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post. After the entry deadline, entries can be made via NRA Reception only

Programme:

- **Cadet 1K:** 1100 yards (1000m), prone, one sighting shot and five shots to count
 - 15 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 11th between 2.30-6.30pm, and Tuesday 12th July between 2-5pm
 - All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA
- **Cadet Clays: Sporting Trap Competition:** Designed to be open to all, but is primarily aimed at Cadets that have already been introduced to the sport and have a degree of competency
 - The competition is carried out over five stands where shooters engage targets that are identified by a letter which is shot in a prescribed sequence on each stand. Once each shooter has completed their stand, they then move to the right and then engage the same targets from a different direction and in a different sequence
 - 20 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 11th between and Tuesday 12th July between 6-8pm
 - All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA in conjunction with the NSCS
- **Cadet Clay: Experience Session:** Designed for cadets who just wish to give clay shooting a go
 - Cadets will get the chance to engage with 10 clays
 - 20 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 11th between and Tuesday 12th July between 6-8pm
 - All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA in conjunction with the NSCS
- **Cadet Gallery Rifle (GRSB):** Standing, targets advance from 25m, cadets must fire 6 shots before targets face. This is repeated for a total of three runs
 - 15 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 11th between and Tuesday 12th July between 6-8pm
 - All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA
- **Cadet McQueen:** McQueen A: Two sighting shots followed by ten appearances of three seconds, with irregular intervals varying between 10 and 20 seconds. Each appearance of the target will be in a different part of the McQueen castle, the sequence being varied for each competitor. One shot to be fired at each appearance
 - 15 minutes slots are bookable on Monday 11th between and Tuesday 12th July between 5.30-8pm
 - All firearms, ammunition and instruction to be provided by NRA

- **Squadding:** You can book a specific timeslot when you enter for each of the above events
- **Team Matches:** For the Cadet 1K, Clays Competition and GRSB, you will receive a FREE Team nomination card for every 4 cadets entered. These nomination cards must be completed before the cadets shoot the event
- **When you Arrive:** Please report to NRA Reception where your School pack, including scorecards for the extra events, will be ready for you to collect
- **Results:** Results will be input on the day of the Competition (where possible) and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults
- **Challenging Results:** It is the competitor's responsibility on the day of the competition to ensure that scores are written down correctly before being signed by the Range Officer and posted in the scorecard box. Any challenges to scores before they are signed off must be made immediately to the Range Team on the day
 - Results will be printed and displayed on the stats board next to the NRA Offices. If you have a query for stats they are located in the NRA Offices
 - Once the Meeting has finished no edits can be made for competitor errors on the scorecards. Following the publishing of scores online competitors have until midday on Monday 18th July to contact the NRA for errors relating to the digitising of the hand recorded scores. Please email competitions@nra.org.uk with any challenges
- **Awards:** NRA Medals, trophies and other sponsored prizes will be presented – see the NRA Handbook for full details
- **Prizegiving:** The Schools Prizegiving will take place on Thursday 14th July at 18:00 in the marquee on Exhibition Lawn. All first, second and third place awards will be presented
- **Terms of Entry:**
 - I agree I meet the entry criteria as stated within the details of the Event I am entering
 - I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
 - I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential')
 - I agree that I have been warned that ear and eye protection must be worn at all times in the vicinity of all firing points while shooting is in progress, and shall not hold the organiser responsible for any injury resulting from non-compliance therewith
 - I confirm that the information given in this form is true, complete and accurate
 - I meet at least one of the following conditions:
 - I hold a Firearm Certificate permitting me to use the firearms that I shall fire in this competition for target shooting
 - I am a full member of a Home Office Approved Club and will be shooting as a full member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
 - I will only shoot with airguns that are exempt from the requirements of S1 and S5 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) and/or with shotguns falling within the limits of S2 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
 - I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Meeting and I will accept the decisions of the Meeting Director or the NRA as final
 - I agree that results of a Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, class and score
