Inter Counties Event Notes

Saturday 11th – Sunday 12th June 2022

- Entry Deadline: Wednesday 1st June at midday
- Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by 8am Wednesday 8th June.
 Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation
- **Discounts:** (off entry fee only)
 - o 40% Off Entry Fees for R Jarvis entrants who are under 25 years old on the last day of the Event
- Entry Requirements:
 - ✓ Competitions are open to members of Home Office Approved Clubs (HOAC) who are not prohibited under section 21 of the Firearms Act (The NRA is the largest HOAC in the UK)
 - ✓ On the first day of the Competition you must be aged 14 or over (please contact the Competition Coordinator before entering if this is not the case)
 - ✓ **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** Each civilian shooting on a MoD or NRA range has to carry a SCC issued by the chairman of a club of which they are a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST be in possession of their SCC when shooting on NRA ranges. All firers are required to bring their Shooter Certification Card (SCC) to present it to their Team Captain for the purposes of the team declaration. If you do not have an SCC for the type of firearm you wish to participate with please contact the Competition Coordinator before entering
- Making an entry: Entries can be made and paid for online via: online.nra.org.uk. A downloadable paper entry form will also be available which can be returned via email or post. All names and GRID numbers of team members need to be supplied prior to the entry deadline
- **Team Composition:** County Squads are formed of 10 firers qualified by birth, residence or vote may represent the County, any eight of whom may shoot in the Team Matches. All firers/coaches/captains must come from the prenominated squad of ten
- Courses of Fire: See the separate Match Conditions document for this event
- Firearms: Please refer to paragraph 150 and 151 of the NRA Handbook for specifications of eligible Target Rifles
- Ammunition: Entries included issued GGG 155g 2022 ammunition for all shooters
- Muzzle Energy: Ranges at Bisley use the Danger Area of Pirbright Range, which under MoD requirements state that all firearms used must either have a muzzle energy under 4,500 Joules (3,319 ft lbs), or else be zeroed at 200 yards or on the Bisley Zero Range prior to being used at a longer distance. If your ME exceeds the limit then you must zero your rifle, using the specially designed target, the day before the start of your particular Meeting
- **Squadding:** Once entries have closed, your entries will be allocated (squadded) and this will be communicated to team captains
- Index Numbers: All individuals will be issued with a unique index number for the Meeting
- **Scorecard Collection:** You can collect scorecards on Friday 10th June from NRA Reception. After this point, packs will be available from the ammunition distribution tent on the morning of Saturday 11th June
- **Scorecards:** Please ensure the Index number of each competitor is listed on the scorecards. Teams are to swap scorecards with neighbouring teams, and register keep for each other. Scorecards must be placed into the scorecard box on range immediately, before leaving the range

- **Awards:** NRA Medals and Trophies are presented to the top scoring teams in each match, as well as awards for the Individual R Jarvis competition. Please refer to the Match Conditions document for full details
- **Prizegiving:** Will take place on Stickledown range following the completion of the Champion of Champions

 - I hold a Firearm Certificate permitting me to use the firearms that I shall fire in this competition for target shooting
 - I am a full member of a Home Office Approved Club and will be shooting as a full member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended
 - I will only shoot with airguns that are exempt from the requirements of S1 and S5 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) and/or with shotguns falling within the limits of S2 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended)
- o I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Meeting and I will accept the decisions of the Meeting Director or the NRA as final
- o I agree that results of a Competition and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere containing my name, competitor number, class and score
