

## The NRA / ARA Military Adaptive Championship 2022

## **Advancing Target**

o Distance 25m-10m

o Position Seated from a bench or Standing

o Rounds 10 sighting shots, then 3 x 10 round Practices

o Target DP1 centre o Scoring X, 5, 4, 3, 2

o HPS 150

o Procedure:

- 1. Firers will have one sighting Practice of 10 rounds, to be shot as the target advances from 25m-10m. After targets have been patched, firers will re-load with 10 rds and adopt the Seated/Standing position
- 2. The target will advance from 25m to 10m in approximately 10 seconds, and will edge at the 10m point. When the target starts to advance, firers may open fire. No more than 10 shots will be counted
- 3. There will be three identical Practices, targets will be scored and patched after each Practice

## Precision, Snaps & Rapid

o Distance 50m

o Position Seated from a bench or Standing

o Rounds Up to 10 sighting shots, then 3 x 10 round Practices

o Targets DP1 centre, DP1 Half Size, DP14

o Scoring X, 5, 4, 3, 2

o HPS 150

- o Procedure:
  - 1. Firers have 45 seconds for their sighting shots. On completion of sighting, ROs will use spotting scopes to indicate the group to firers and make any sight adjustments. The match then consists of three Practices:
    - Practice 1 Precision: The target will make one appearance of 60 seconds, 10 shots to be fired on the top right target (DP1 Half Size)
    - o Practice 2 Snaps: The target will make 10 exposures of 3 seconds, with intervals of 3 seconds. 1 shot to be fired at each exposure on the bottom left target (DP14)
    - o Practice 3 Rapid: The target will make 3 exposures of 4 seconds, with intervals of 4 seconds. 10 shots are to be fired at the bottom right hand target (DP1 centre). Any number of shots may be fired at each exposure
  - 2. On completion of the match, targets will be collected by range staff and returned to the FP for scoring

## The McQueen

o Distance 50m

o Position Seated from a bench

o Rounds Up to 10 sighting shots, then 10 to count

Targets DP14Scoring X, 5, 4, 3, 2

o HPS 50

- o Procedure:
  - 1. Firers have up to 10 sighting shots. On completion of sighters, rifles will be loaded and made ready
  - 2. The target will make ten exposures of 3 seconds, with irregular intervals varying between 10 and 20 seconds. Targets will appear randomly in the McQueen 'Castle', one shot to be fired per exposure
  - 3. On completion of the match, targets will be collected by range staff and returned to the FP for scoring
