NRA TARGET RIFLE COURSE – UNIT 1: INTRODUCTION TO TARGET RIFLE Sunday 1 March 2020

Welcome to the Fullbore Target Rifle Skills Programme for novice shooters!

The programme is comprised of 6 training units designed to help you develop the skills and confidence you need to shoot independently, enter competitions and take part in team matches. You may opt to follow this as a full programme or you can book onto the individual units that you need.

Unit 1 will introduce you to Target Rifle and cover foundation marksmanship principles

Units 2 - 4 will cover the core information and skills you need to shoot independently

Units 5 and 6 will help you to prepare for competition and team match shooting

Unit 1: AIM to introduce you to Fullbore Target Rifle, whilst covering the following topics:

- Fullbore Target Rifle as a sport discipline
- Basic equipment you will need to participate
- Fullbore prone position
- Essential Fullbore marksmanship principles
- How to shoot precise groups with a target rifle at short range

PREREQUISITE

The course is open any NRA Member who has a Shooter Certification Card (SCC), including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess a Target Rifle.

Non-NRA members can also attend providing they are a full member of a Home Office approved club affiliated to the NRA and possess a Shooter Certification Card (SCC). An additional non-membership fee will also be applicable.

RANGE TIME

2 Hour morning session at 300x

3 Hour afternoon session 600x

The Classroom location for the course will be the NRA Training Room at the rear of the main NRA Building.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is £105.00 (£63.00 for Under 25s) which includes individual use of a firearm, ammunition, coaching, range fees, markers, plotting sheets and all essential TR equipment.

Cancellations received before midday Wednesday 26th February will incur £5 fee

Cancellations received after midday Wednesday 26th February will incur a £20 fee

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

All firearms, ammunition and shooting equipment will be provided. You are welcome to bring your own ear protection, shooting glove, hat, notebook, pen and any glasses if you need them. Attendees should wear their usual shooting clothing, with under layers according to the weather. Please bring waterproof trousers, jackets and sturdy footwear suitable for soggy ranges - avoid highly padded or very baggy jackets if you can.

Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom session of the course at no extra charge. Lunch will be provided.

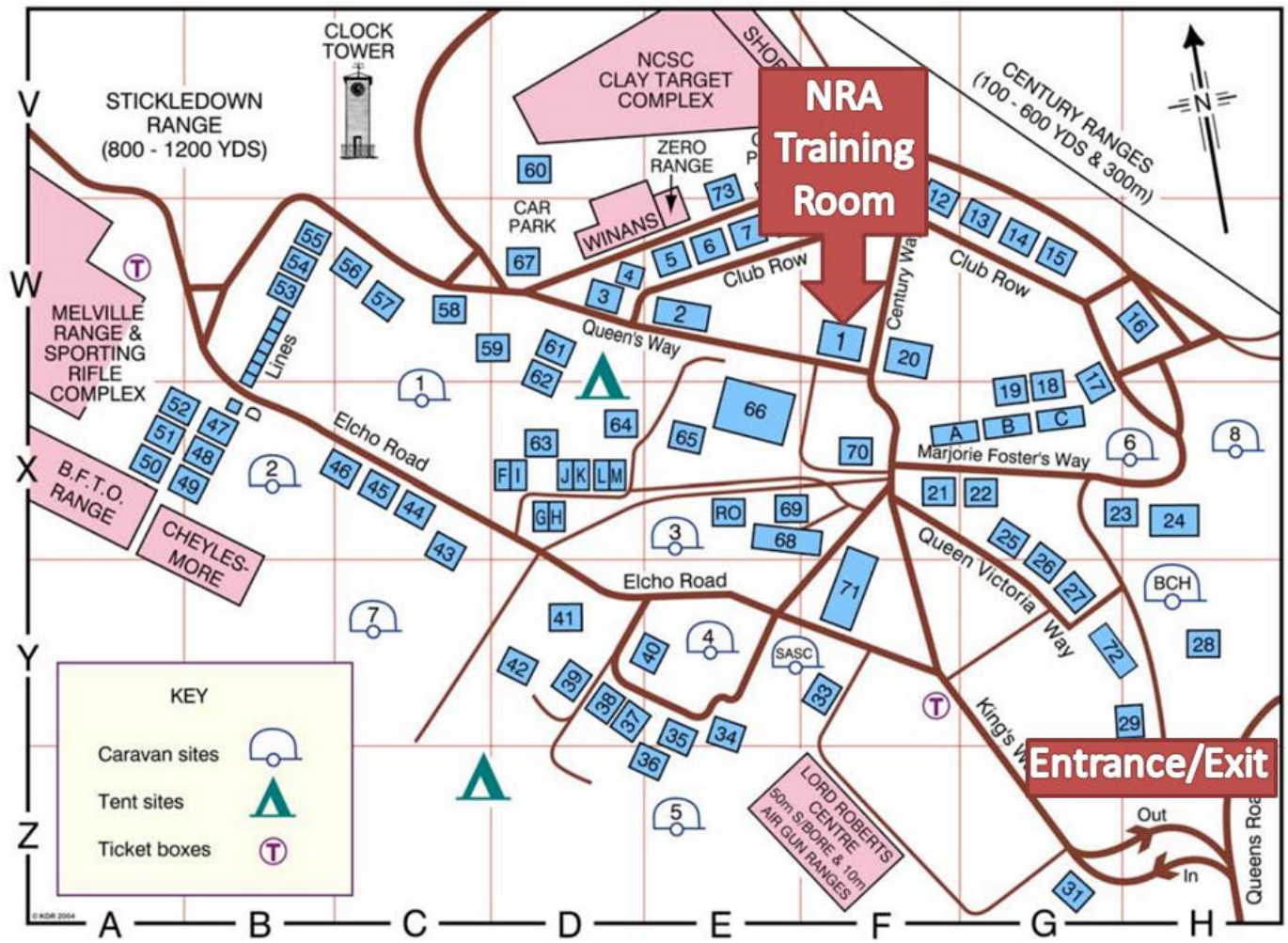
