

## **CSR League 2022/23 Competition Notes**

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2022

This CSR Meeting will contest the Urban, Short Range and Whitehead Matches

• **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** Each civilian shooting on a MoD or NRA range is to carry a SCC issued by a chairman of a club of which they are a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST be in possession of their SCC when shooting on NRA ranges.

• Classes:

Any SMLE/ No.4/ No. 5 rifle, service pattern as issued, with no attachments
 Any Iron: Any rifle with iron sights, with no restriction on slings (but rests may not be used)

o Service Optic: Any rifle with optic sights, max 4.5 magnification with no restriction on slings. Rests may

not be used. (Any vertical or angled fore grip, if fitted, may be used)

o Practical Optic: Any rifle with optic sights, with no restriction on slings or rests. If any rest is utilised it

must remain fitted to the rifle at all times during the match

• **Discounts:** (off entry fee only)

o 40% discount for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Event

• Entry Deadline: Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September at midday

- Cancellations: Cancellations must be received via email to <u>competitions@nra.org.uk</u> by 8am Thursday 29<sup>th</sup>
  September. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable.
  Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation.
- **Event Conditions:** Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the CSR Handbook which can be found online at nra.org.uk/nra-handbooks, and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception
- **Squadding:** You will be squadded into one of 6 groups. In the "AM" session between 08:30-15:00 competitors will rotate between firing the Urban Match on Short Siberia, firing the Short Range Match on Century and operating targetry in the Century Butts. In the PM session you will be squadded into one of 4 groups, who will rotate between firing and operating targetry in the Butts. There will always be two groups on the firing point, and two in the butts at any time, so if you are physically unable to operate targets there will be additional competitors available to assist.

Once entries to the event have closed, you will be emailed a copy of the squadding, which will also be available at <a href="nra.org.uk/csr-squadding">nra.org.uk/csr-squadding</a>, updated live until 4pm on the last working day before the match.

- On the day: All competitors must head straight to the range for the pre-event briefing, there are no packs to collect from NRA Reception
- **Results:** Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: <a href="mailto:nra.org.uk/liveresults">nra.org.uk/liveresults</a>
- **Awards:** NRA Medals and awards are presented based on the final results in the CSR League, not for individual competitions. NRA Medals are awarded in each event in each class subject to Prize List D of the NRA handbook:

o 2+ Entries: Gold Medal

o 6+ Entries: Gold and Silver Medal

o 11+ Entries: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal

• **Prizegiving:** Prizegiving will take place on Saturday 1st July 2023, following the completion of the Individual CSR Imperial Competitions.
