Gallery Rifle & Pistol Skills Course

Saturday 8th October 2022

This course will introduce you to specific techniques needed for Gallery Rifle and Pistol shooting at a Club level, as well as providing guidance to those wishing to progress into competitive shooting. The day comprises of both classroom and practical range work, with expert coaching from national and international level shooters

Entry Requirements:

- The course is open to any person who is not a prohibited person under section 21 of the Firearms Act, and is a member of a Home Office Approved Club (The NRA is a Home Office Approved Club)

Course Fee:

- Entry to the course is £75.50 which includes use of Cheylesmore Range, targets and coaching. Under 25s receive a 40% discount off the entry fee
 - The entry does not include refreshments or lunch – you will need to source your own
- Non-NRA members are welcome, but are required to pay an additional Non-NRA Member Fee of £7.75
- Rifle and Ammunition are not included and attendees are expected to bring their own. If not yet in possession of a suitable firearm attendees can have use of an NRA firearm (Scoped Ruger 10/20) for £24.00 for the day, and purchase sufficient ammunition (CCI.22LR Mini-Mag) for £26.00, both will be issued on the range by the Instructor.

Dress & Equipment:

Attendees should bring warm weatherproof clothing and appropriate footwear in case of inclement weather.

You will need:

- Safety glasses & Ear defenders
- Firearm:
 - **Gallery Rifles:** You can attend even if you are not yet in possession of a suitable rifle – although we do encourage you to bring your own so you can become more proficient with it
 - **Long-Barrelled Pistol or Revolver:** If you are in possession of an LBP or LBR the course will be suitable for you
- Approximately 200 rounds of suitable ammunition
- Normal shooting equipment
- Notebook and pencil
