CSR League 2022/23 Competition Notes

Saturday 7th January 2023

This CSR Meeting will contest the Long Range Practices (AM), then Short Range Practices (PM).

- **Shooter Certification Card (SCC):** Each civilian shooting on a MoD or NRA range is to carry a SCC issued by a chairman of a club of which they are a member and which is affiliated to the NRA. Competitors MUST be in possession of their SCC with shooting on NRA ranges.
- **Classes:**
 - Historic: Any SMLE/ No.4/ No. 5 rifle, service pattern as issued, with no attachments
 - Any Iron: Any rifle with iron sights, with no restriction on slings (but rests may not be used)
 - Service Optic: Any rifle with optic sights, max 4.5 magnification with no restriction on slings. Rests may not be used. (Any vertical or angled fore grip, if fitted, may be used)
 - Practical Optic: Any rifle with optic sights, with no restriction on slings or rests. If any rest is utilised it must remain fitted to the rifle at all times during the match
- **Discounts:** (*off entry fee only*)
 - **£4.75 discount** for those entering both the AM and PM Competitions
 - **40% discount** for those that are under 25 years old on the last day of the Event
- **Entry Deadline:** Tuesday 3rd January at midday
- **Cancellations:** Cancellations must be received via email to competitions@nra.org.uk by **8am Thursday 5th January**. Entries will be fully refunded (or credited) before this time, after this point entries are non-refundable. Credits are valid for 12 months from the date of cancellation.
- **Event Conditions:** Conditions and courses of fire are listed in the CSR Handbook which can be found online and in a FREE paperback book available from NRA Reception
- **Squadding:** You will be 'squadded' into one of 4 groups, who will rotate between firing and operating targetry in the Butts. There will always be two groups on the firing point, and two in the butts at any time, so if you are physically unable to operate targets there should be additional competitors available to assist.
Once entries to the event have closed, you will be emailed a copy of the squadding, this should also be available to view at www.nra.org.uk/csrsquadding from 4pm the Tuesday preceding the event.
- **On the day:** Please head straight to the range for the pre-event briefing, there are no packs to collect from NRA Reception.
- **Results:** Results will be input on the day of the Competition and will be available online: www.nra.org.uk/liveresults
- **Awards:**
 - Vortex Sponsored (Class Specific):** This year Vortex are generously supporting the encouragement of up and coming shooters with prizes for the highest scoring competitor in the lowest class in each of the four rifle types
 - Historic Enfield 'A' Class - Vortex Binoculars
 - Any Iron 'A' Class - Vortex Binoculars
 - Practical Optic 'B' Class - Vortex Scope
 - Service Optic 'B' Class - Vortex Scope
 - NRA Awards (Classless/Overall League):** The highest scores overall in each rifle type, regardless of class, will be awarded with a piece of etched glassware, as per the below;
 - Historic Enfield 1st & 2nd highest scorers
 - Any Iron 1st & 2nd highest scorers
 - Practical Optic 1st, 2nd & 3rd highest
 - Service Optic 1st, 2nd & 3rd highest
 - NRA Awards (Classified League):** NRA Medals are awarded in each event and to each class, subject to Prize List 'D' of the NRA handbook;
 - 2+ Entries: Gold Medal
 - 6+ Entries: Gold and Silver Medal
 - 11+ Entries: Gold, Silver Medal and Bronze Medal
- **Prizegiving:** Prizegiving will take place on Saturday 1st July 2023, following the completion of the Individual CSR Imperial Competitions.
