Open competition for Small-Bore Rifles

Rifles: Any single shot rifle chambered for .22 Long Rifle, Long or Short Rimfire ammunition may be used. Magazine rifles must be loaded by single shots. A sling may be used. Competitors can compete in the following classes:

MRSB Class: Iron, magnifying or telescopic sights may be fitted. The forward hand may also be rested, but the rifle itself may not touch the rest and the butt may not be rested or touch the ground

TRSB Class: Iron sights only. The forward hand may not be rested. Entries to TRSB are also eligible for MRSB prizes

SRSB Class: British or foreign military training rifles such as the Enfield No 2, 8 or 9, foreign equivalents or Morris tube conversions, fitted with Iron sights of any type. The forward hand may not be rested. Entries to SRSB are also eligible for TRSB and MRSB prizes

Competitions:

- No 1. 200 yards
- No 2. 300 yards
- No 3. 200 & 300 yards aggregate

Competitors will be squadded to a target in advance of the competition in pairs or threes at each distance.

Number of Shots: Blow-off shots (see below), up to 3 practice shots, 2 convertible sighting shots and 15 shots to count at each distance

Blow-Off Shots: A period of one minute during which blow-off (warming) shots may be fired at the stop butt will be allowed before shooting for score commences at 200 and 300 yards

Timing of Shots: The time allowed for each shot will be 45 seconds (NRA rule 351)

Targets:

200 yards: NRA/HBSA Round Bull (V Bull 3.5, Bull 5, Inner 12, Magpie 24, Outer 35 inch dia)

300 yards: NRA/HBSA Round Bull (V Bull 5, Bull 7.5, Inner 18, Magpie 30, Outer 35 inch dia)

Marking/Scoring: Markers will be provided. Standard NRA scoring will be used

Ammunition: Competitors are to supply their own ammunition

Firing Position: Prone or Supine. Competitors with disabilities may be permitted to shoot seated at a table (NRA rule 156)

Prize Giving: Prize giving will take place at the 300 yards Firing Point at 1730 hrs

Prizes: NRA medals are awarded per class in each of the above competitions, depending on the amount of entries:

Gold Medal: 2 - 8 Competitors

Silver Medal: 9 - 20 Competitors

Bronze Medal: 21+ Competitors
